I believe indeed, though I am not sufficiently acquainted with foreign languages to speak with certainty on that point, that the Englishman is the only person in the world who applies a capital letter to himself."

BAIT ASSOCIATIONS.—Mr. McFarlane, of the Marine and Fisheries Dept., Ottawa, is in this province promoting the establishment of fishermen's bait associations. He is advertised to address meetings as follows:

St. Peter's Bay, Monday, January 29. Rusticville, Wednesday, January 31. New London, Thursday, Feb. 1. Malpique, Friday, Feb. 2.

It is probable that bait-freezing stations will be established at Tignish, Souris, Murray Harbor and other points. The cost of an ice-house, freezer and cold storage having a capacity of ten tons is estimated at about \$500; one for fifteen tons would cost about \$700. Plans of required buildings designed by Professor Robertson, will be supplied by the Department of Marine and Fisheries. The Government will assist all associations establishing freezers and cold storage for bait at the rate of \$5 per ton.
