

CURRENT NOTES.

Mr. C. J. Brydges has been elected president of the Board of Trade for the ensuing year.

According to the returns of the statistical department at Washington, as given in a special bulletin just issued, the exportation from the United States of provisions, tallow, and dairy produce for 1882 showed a very considerable decline as compared with that of the previous year, the total amounts being \$96,934,000 and \$133,332,000 respectively.

M. Asakoff, who was on intimate terms with General Skobelev, publishes in the last number of his paper, the St. Petersburg Bus, an interesting account of the celebrated speech to the Serbian delegation that rang like a war cry through Europe. It appears the speech was in reality never delivered, but was concocted by Camille Faroy from statements of students, pieced by all the ingenuity and talent at the command of the Nouvelle Revue.

A cable despatch from Berlin states that the press there continue to discuss methods for preventing collisions at sea. The Messrs. Siemens, "point out the advantages of lighting vessels by electricity, instancing the escape of the steamer Faraday by this means when laying cables."
