Eighteen contestants from eleven Island centers plied their driving skills Saturday afternoon for the opportunity of participating in the Teen Age Safe Driving Road-E-O Maritime Regional competition in Saint John, N.B., June 8th, and the National finals to be held in London, Ontario, July 12th. Scholarships to the value of \$1,700 will be awarded the winners of the final competition.

Malcolm MacRae of Cherry Valley was declared the winner and will represent the Island teen-age drivers at St. John, along with the winner of the contest being held by the Montague Junior Board of Trade at Montague later this week.

Malcolm MacRae is no stranger to driving competitions: in 1956 he won the Esso Maritime Plowing Match.

Other winners at Saturday's Road-E-O were Donald Arsenault, Charlottetown, who placed second; Cyril Gallant of Souris West and Kenneth Thompson, Dunstaffnage, who tied for third place, and Miss Blanche Hamill, Summerside, best lady driver. J.H. Cerry of Imperial Oil, presented the prizes.

Sees Souris Becoming Great Fishing Centre

When the Island dragger "Harry G", under the command of Captain Raymond Griffin arrived at Souris last week with almost sixty-six thousand pounds of fish, it not only heralded the opening of the fishing season but a success for a very close-knit family, a father and son combination, the Griffins.

Possibly nowhere in Canada are there three more hard-working people, day in and day out. All three have a vision of Souris as a great fishing centre, which will in the years to come attain a similar position to that of Gloucester, in New England or Lunenburg in Nova Scotia. It is the firmly held conviction of the Griffins that with any kind of luck, Souris will become one of the greatest fishing centres in Canada, on the eastern coast.

It was somewhat of confirmation, that the Griffin dream would come true, when their son Raymond, thus early in the season landed the immense catch of almost 66,000 lbs. on his first trip, composed mostly of grey sole, haddock and a small proportion of halibut.

Immediately several American buyers wanted to purchase the early cargo at good prices, and Mr. Albert Griffin was quick to point out that Souris was favourably placed in the North Atlantic to provide the American and Upper Canadian markets, with fresh fish at an earlier date, than any other fishing centre on the American or Canadian coast.

WELL EQUIPPED
The Griffin plant at Souris is one of the best equipped on the eastern coast of Canada, and at the present time is geared up and ready to process any amount of fish. The plant expects a number of boats to land fish in the near future, and Mr. Albert Griffin, its manager is optimistic about the fishing industry in the period ahead.

Mr. Griffin personally has the utmost faith in the fishing industry, and is noted as being one of the hardest workers associated with fishing in the province. His wife, who is in charge of the Griffin Fishing offices is just as enthusiastic, and her office hours are not confined to the forty hour week. She works sixty to seventy hours every week and apparently enjoys it. Not less interested is the son of the family Mr. Raymond Griffin, who as captain of the dragger "Harry G", has again

and again brought record catches of ground fish ashore, and who believes that dragger fishing out of Souris has only been scratched. The Griffin family not only work hard themselves they are instrumental in providing employment for more than 150 people.
