COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS

For students graduating in May of '84: Those who wish to pursue postgraduate study in a foreign country for the academin year '84-85 should be aware that the deadline for most of the Commonwealth countries is October 31st, 1983. The deadline for Australia and New Zealand is December 31st, 1983. These awards are available to men and women who are Canadian citizens who wish to pursue postgraduate studies. P.E.I. PUBLIC SERVICE ASSOCIATION, INC.

PAULIAMENTARY INTERNSHIPS (CANADIAN POLITICAL SCIENCE ASSOC.)

This internship involves working as an assistant to a member of the House of Commons in Ottawa. You will be assigned specific responsibilities and upon completion, must prepare a paper analyzing an aspect of parliamentary

government in Canada. The internships are open to men and women who have recently graduated or will be graduating. They run for 10 months from September 1984. You are awarded a stipend of approximately \$8,000 for this period. deadline is January 9th.
