Brazil's Top Problem Found In Area Of Sugar Plantations

RIO DE JANEIRO (AP)—One of the worst problem areas of Brazil is the region of sugar cane plantations on the northeast coast near the city of Recife. Significantly this is also one of the most active areas for Communist agitation. The cane farms are worked by laborers who earned until recently about \$120 a year. They live in small shacks around the cane fields. An American official visiting one of the farms found two families totaling 17 persons housed in two tiny rooms. The laborers and their families, about 1,000,000, are mixtures of Indian, Negro and European stock. Their chief foods are beans and manioc flour. They are illiterate and for generations they passively accepted their misery. Within the last year there have been riots in the region. Armed workers in several instances marched on the sugar cane mills and forced them to close down. Tension between the farm owners and their laborers is high. **SET MINIMUM WAGE**—Last January the Brazilian government established a minimum wage for rural workers as well as city workers. The base of the wage system is 21,000 cruzeiros a month (about \$21 at the current exchange rate). The farm operators said they could not pay that rate and survive. The Brazilian government finally agreed to lend them a little additional push in the inflationary spiral. Communist leaders, branched out of his home area and began stumping the country. 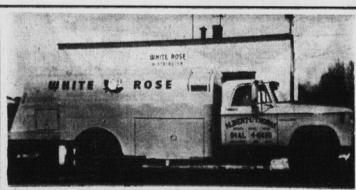

Gen. Foulkes Gives Outline For Integration of Forces

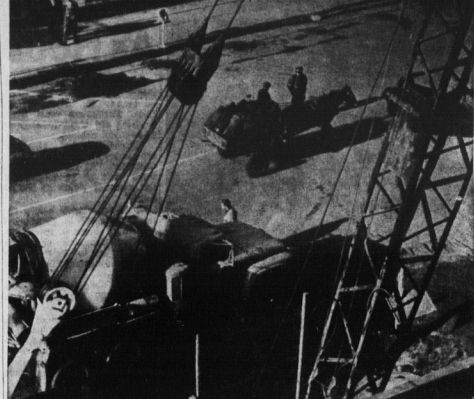
OTTAWA (CP)—Gen. Charles Foulkes, former chairman of the chiefs of staff committee, has offered the Commons defence committee his outline for integration of the armed forces. He said a "comprehensive plan" was recommended by the chiefs "four or five years ago" to then Defence Minister George Pearkes. But integration had been tried "from the bottom" and didn't work. It would have to be imposed by government decision from the top. His step-by-step integration plan:

1. Placing of all senior officers—Lieutenant Colonel or equivalent and above—on one armed forces list from which commanders would be drawn.
 2. Selection of a chief of personnel and a chief of supply for all services.
 3. The chiefs of staff should be relieved of their present duties and ordered to sit in constant session to achieve integration.
 4. With administration settled, the personnel of the armed forces would be grouped in task forces instead of services. For instance, there would be a task force for anti-submarine operations instead of the present RCAF/NAVY combination.
 5. Training would be the job of one officer responsible to the chief of the armed forces.
- Gen. Foulkes said such integration plan would take four to five years to implement but would eliminate "duplication and triplication" in the armed forces.

Ban Consultation Said Inadequate

BONN (Reuters)—Former foreign minister Heinrich von Brentano said here consultation among Britain, the U.S. and the Western allies before the Moscow partial test ban agreement was "inadequate." Making what he called a "friendly reminder" at the opening of a parliamentary debate on Chancellor Ludwig Erhard's policy declaration, he called for improved political co-operation and consultation among the NATO partners. "A condition of joint defence is that a joint political will is behind it," he said. "If, in a given situation, there is no time for mutual consultation, the partners should be speedily informed."

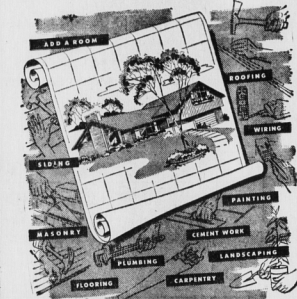
CANADIAN STUDIES—Roughly one-third of all known radial velocities in the study of astrophysics have been determined in Canada.
