Sinclair's Views On Doukhobors Sparks Demand

VANCOUVER (CP)—The CBC has sent a transcript to columnist Gordon Sinclair's remarks on Doukhobors to T. A. McRae, Rosland, B.C., with an invitation that he comment on it.

Mr. McRae, chairman of the Kootenay and Boundary Citizens Committee on Doukhobor Canadian Affairs, has demanded that the Toronto Star writer publicly apologize for remarks he made about the sect in a broadcast of the television program Front Page Challenge Dec. 11.

The CBC said it would be pleased to receive any comment Mr. McRae wished to make.

Mr. McRae said indignation was aroused by Mr. Sinclair's airing of the handling of the Doukhobor problem to the treatment of Canadian-Japanese who were moved from the West Coast early in the Second World War.

Mr. Sinclair has said in Toronto that under no circumstances would he apologize.

Montreal Has Busy Season

MONTREAL (CP)—Port Manager Guy Beaudet has reported that this season ranks next to 1961 as the busiest in the history of Montreal harbor.

He said at a press conference that 20,700 tons of cargo moved through the port this season. The 1961 volume was 21,500,000 tons.

The port handled 5,911 ships compared with 4,991 last year. Passenger arrivals totalled 41,000 against 63,300 and embarkations 57,600 against 59,124.

Mr. Beaudet also said the St. Lawrence Seaway, continues to assist the waterfront economy here rather than detract from it.

Christmas Mail To Be On Time

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—For the first time on record, residents of St. Anthony on the northern tip of Newfoundland will get their Christmas mail on time.

D. R. Clarke, district director of postal services, said here two truck loads of mail have been sent from Corner Brook along the newly opened Northern Peninsula Road.

Carrying more than 720 pounds of mail, the two trucks will meet the CNR coastal vessel Nonia at St. Anthony to transfer part of the load for delivery down the eastern side of the peninsula, where there is no road.

"They wouldn't have had mail by Christmas without this special trip," Mr. Clarke said.

Unique Labor Contract Seen

FONTANA, Calif. (AP)—Details of a unique labor contract designed to give workers a share of production cost savings were announced here by Kaiser Steel Corporation and the United Steel Workers (AFL-CIO).

The plans also calls for protection of workers against loss of employment because of automation.

Dr. George W. Taylor, chairman of the nine-man committee which drew up the plan, told a press conference the contract is a product of the need for "social inventiveness" in labor problems.

The plan provides for a monthly sharing with employees of all savings in the use of materials and supplies and from increased productivity of labor.

Employees' share of the total net dollar gain would be 32.5 per cent.

Balance of the dollar saved would be divided between the company and the public through taxes.

Boy Suffocates In Home Washer

WILMINGTON, Del. (AP)—Four-year-old Collin David Roberts, who curled up in a washing machine to look at a picture book, suffocated Saturday after the door snapped shut.

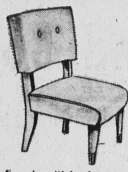

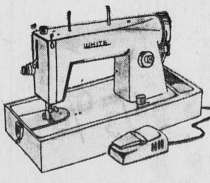

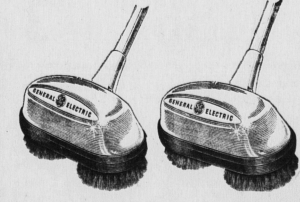
