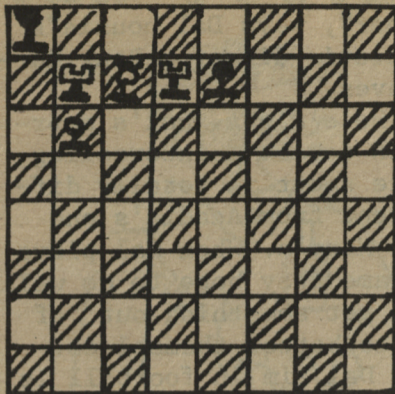


The Queen Traps Her Leader

tract easily, sluffing off a diamond on the fourth Club.

It seems that we should not be hard on East for not knowing that the diamond lead would set the contract. After all, if declarer has the ace and some small diamonds, that lead would give him an overtrick. Yet when making the heart lead, East committed an unforgiveable sin. He forgot to count tricks. He knows (or should know) that South has six spade tricks. Both the bidding and the play point to that. Add a heart trick and three club tricks and you have a contract where the tricks are there for the taking. East-West, then must take four tricks before South gets back in. Hence to have any hope of setting the contract he must lead a diamond, hopin that West has the ace and South at least three small

As a final note, if South had had the ace of diamonds in addition to his six spades would he not have made a slam try after North opened two No Trump?

South immediately stepped up with the club ace preferring to defer the finesse until after the trump are drawn for fear of the singleton lead. After all the outstanding trumps are have drawn, he then leads for the finesse, losing to East's Queen. East, preferring to lead back a solid suit rather than a broken one returned the heart king.
