The Hon. Victor Marchand, (above) has been re-elected chairman of the board of Melchers Distilleries Limited at the annual meeting held in Montreal on Wednesday.

In his remarks to the shareholders, Hon. Mr. Marchand, pointed out the excellent progress shown in the last report, covering the activities of the Company in 1951. He emphasized particularly the growing profits accruing from sales, this despite the fact of higher labour costs, etc. Although in many cases taxes climbed to \$164,000 for the year compared with \$122,000 in 1950, the net profits remained high at \$103,595.46, he said.
