### Potato Bulletin

Colorado beetles have been observed in many early planted potato fields, according to Bulletin No. 1 issued by the Science Service Laboratory, Charlottetown. Other fields will be attacked as the plants emerge from the soil. Because the damage inflicted by these insects on small plants can be very severe, the application of DDT is recommended. Also, by controlling the pest early in the season, the population of the second generation, which appears in mid-summer, will be greatly reduced. Fields may be treated with 50W DDT at 2 pounds per 100 gallons of water, or dusted with a 3 per cent dust. By closing off the side nozzles of the head nozzle per row, the DDT spray mixture when applied to small potato plants will cover a much greater area.

### Well Known South Shore Farmer Dies

Seymour F. Murphy 77, well known and successful farmer of South Shore, died in the Charlottetown Hospital yesterday afternoon following an illness which necessitated his hospitalization three weeks ago.

Mr. Murphy, who resided on the homestead during his entire life, except for a period in which he attended St. Dunstan's College, was particularly successful in raising beef cattle. He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Murphy.

Surviving relatives, in addition to his wife, the former Emaline Burdett of Fairview, are two brothers Wellington, in Charlottetown and Alfred in Western Canada.

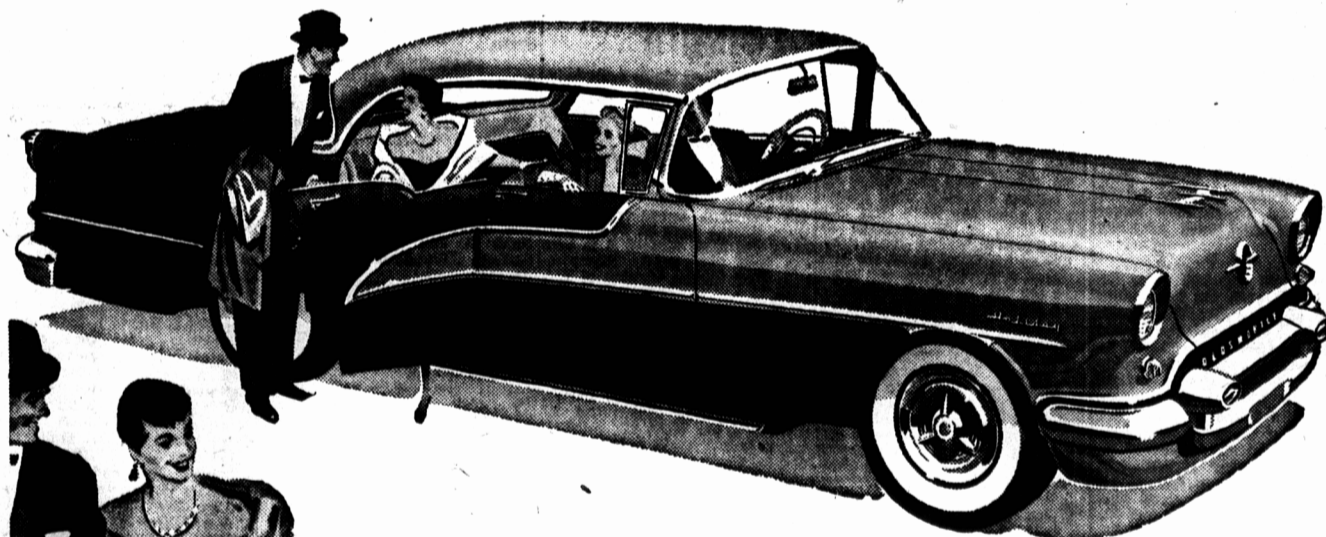

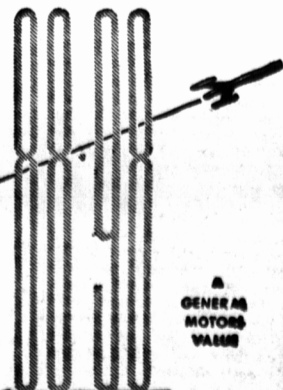
