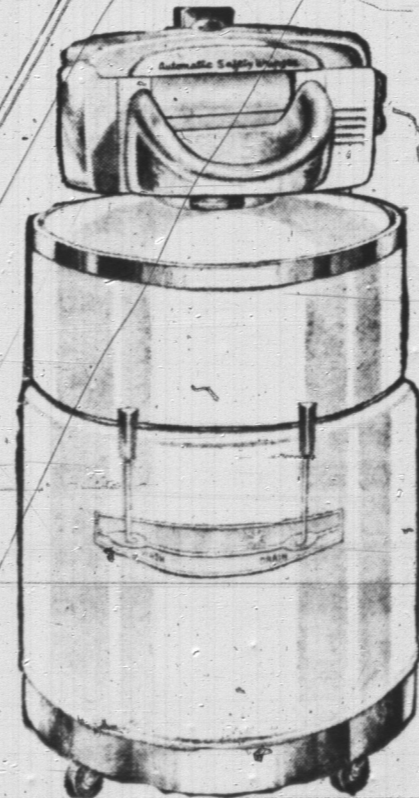

Premier Announces Appointment

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP) - Deputy Mayor John Crosbie, 35-year-old city lawyer, was sworn in Tuesday as a member of the provincial cabinet. Premier Joseph Smallwood told a press conference that Beaton J. Abbott had resigned as municipal affairs and supply minister earlier in the day and the portfolio had been assumed by Mr. Crosbie. The Premier said the ministry would be split at the next legislative session and Mr. Crosbie would become minister of municipal affairs and housing. Mr. Abbott would take over as minister of supply, which would become a full-fledged department responsible for \$25,000,000 worth of government purchasing annually. The Premier said the changes in effect would be put into force at once but the official splitting of the portfolio and creation of the new department of supply must await the next House sitting. Mr. Crosbie, who became deputy mayor after his first try in politics during the civic elections last November, said he will run for the provincial seat of St. John's West in the next byelection or general election. The seat was held by Liberal William Adams until he resigned to contest successfully the mayoralty in November.

Soviet Plants On New System

MOSCOW AP - Some 400 Soviet factories were put on a new planning system July 1 that gives individual plant bosses more authority and stresses profits and sales. Pravda said Tuesday. The Soviet Communist party newspaper said preliminary results show the new system is working better. Soviet industry is supposed to shift gradually to the new system by Jan. 1, 1968. Successful plants are changing over first but problems are expected to arise when less successful plants make the shift. Last fall Soviet Premier Alexei N. Kosygin ordered a sweeping program of economic reform.

Bureau Reveals Weakness

OTTAWA (CP) - The coal and uranium industries reveal the only signs of weakness this year among the 19 major areas of mineral production the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported Tuesday. A survey showed coal production down to 4,166,520 tons in the first four months of 1966 from 4,400,685 tons for the same period of 1965. Production of uranium in the end of April was 2,610,279 pounds, down from 3,440,490 a year earlier.

Natural gas movements were well ahead to 542,324,887,000 cubic feet from 510,165,853,000. Petroleum shipments reached 116,756,110 barrels, compared with 107,430,86. Molybdenum production hit its stride at 2,242,205 pounds for the four months after only 608,217 in the same 1965 period. Potash producers shipped 666,892 tons, compared with 413,181. Other January-April production with comparable 1965 totals bracketed: Copper 161,432 tons (160,625); lead 90,817 tons (88,049); nickel 89,967 tons (89,903); silver 10,239,352 troy ounces (9,613,165); zinc 303,070 tons (255,318). Measures by shipments: Asbestos 432,160 tons (329,512); cement 1,996,358 (1,534,256); clay products \$10,896,842 (9,432,888); gypsum 1,378,005 tons (1,449,315); iron ore 6,537,049 tons (6,652,481); lime 521,337 tons (509,171); salt 1,415,093 tons (1,399,180).
