During the past week in India, Muslims set fire to a train of Hindu nationalists, killing 58. More than 300 Muslims and Hindus were killed in fires and other religious violence and retaliatory killings over the next three days.

American-led troops have herded the remaining al-Qaeda and Taliban forces in Afghanistan—US intelligence puts the number somewhere between one and five thousand—into the eastern mountains where they will be slaughtered in revenge for the September 11th terror-

ist attacks on the US.

In the Middle East, Palestinian suicide bombers and snipers continue to murder helpless Israeli citizens, while the Israeli army continues to murder helpless Palestinians with rocket, helicopter, tank, and small arms fire.

All sides continue to condemn the revenge attacks of whoever it is they're killing.
