**MONEY PACER**

Phillip Scott p, 1:59 2-5, a son of Scotland 1:59 1/4 and Hollywood Phyllis 2:00 1/2, is being placed in the stud at Walnut Hall Farm, Kentucky. Phillip Scott is one of the leading all time money winning pacers with earnings of over \$230,000 and he was racing right up until a couple of months ago. He is the property of Gray Bros. and George W. Reed.

The Hollywood, California meet came to a close November 17th and new mutual and attendance records were established. A total of \$21,620,753 passed through the mutuels. Times Square won the feature race that day. It was the \$10,000 Consolation Pace of the American Pacing Classic which was won in straight heats by Dotty's Pick. The \$7,500 Invitation Trot from which Scott Frost was excluded, was won by Jean Lairs that had headed Scott Frost in one of the three dashes of the \$75,000 American Trotting Classic. Scott Frost won the other two.

There was tremendous applause when it was announced that Del Miller's Dotty's Pick had set up a new world's record for pacing mares that afternoon of 1:57 4-5. The 4-year-old daughter of Adios is owned by J.E. and C.E. Armstrong of Arnprior, Ont. The former record was 1:58 1-4 made by Miss Harris M in 1938.

On November 13th the C Trot purse \$1,500, was won by Watchin's Lady by Watchin' 2:06 in 1:09 1-5 and the A Pace, feature event of the afternoon, purse \$3,000, was won by Hawkins Boss, driven by Clarence Hansen. He headed some of the best horses racing at Hollywood including Ribbons, Victory Song, Imo Handover, Sea Eagle and Meadow Pace, in 2:01 1-5. The owner is Walter S. Found of Merced, formerly of New London, P.E.I. Just a few days previously Mr. Found's pacer Misstatement won a \$2,000 purse over the same track. A poll of local harness writers who were asked to name the "horse of the meeting" gave the award to Scott Frost with Dotty's Pick runner up.

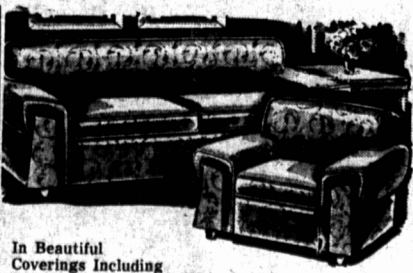

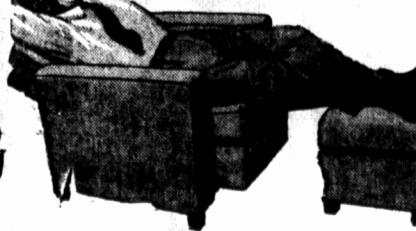
