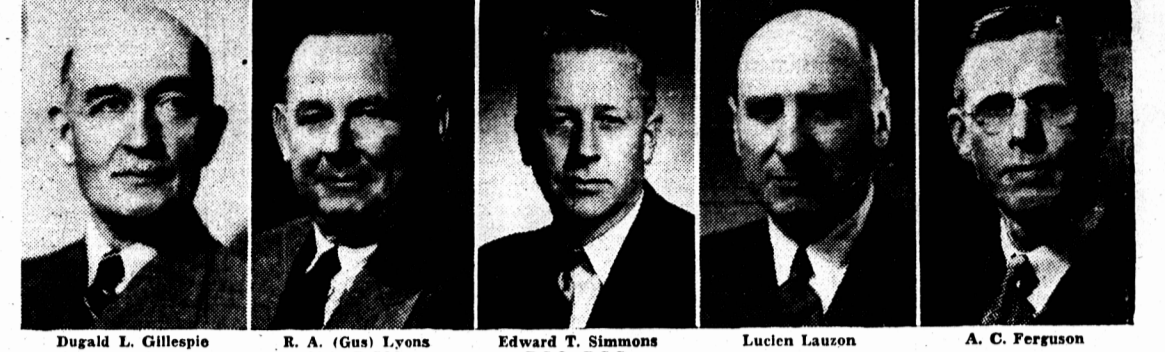

WINNIPEG, April 24 - (CP) - Prices of coarse grains futures generally were sharply lower today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. The decline reflected the prairies continued good weather for spring harvest, heavy grain deliveries and declines in U.S. grain and commodity markets. Commercial demand was moderate. It included some U.S. shipping demand for oats, processor buying in barley and a few purchases in flax. Hedging sales and offerings featured rye. Oats and flax prices dipped to seasonal lows. There were reports that a cargo of 300,000 bushels of Canadian barley had been sold for export to Denmark. Export loadings of Canadian wheat reported overnight included: United Kingdom 800,000 bushels, Italy 325,000, Chile 365,000, Norway 20,000. Prices for class two and I.W.A. wheat were unchanged.
