

**M. Y. Fans Want
Ron Murphy**

NEW YORK (CP)—Unlike Toronto's Conn Smythe, who acquired goalie Harry Lumley from Chicago a few years ago with the "in - cheek announcement" that he was yielding to popular demand, New York Rangers have never conceded that the voice from the alley influences their personnel changes.

But there certainly has been an insistent demand from at least a portion of the public for the recall of Ron Murphy, who rejoined the National Hockey League club this weekend after half a season's exile at Providence.
The well-organized New York Ranger Fan Club habitually brightens Madison Square Garden by hanging banners on its upper railings extolling the virtues of one or another of the team's heroes. Its activities emphatically are not subject to control of the Ranger management.
Coach Phil Watson may choose to plant a barb in the hide of defenceman Lou Fontinato or goalie Lorne Worsley by issuing a statement to the press decrying their performance. As likely as not, an additional Fontinato or Worsley banner hangs from the rail the next time the Rangers hit the Garden.

DROPPED IRWIN
The fan club's first full-scale rebellion came last year when Watson gave up on Ivan Irwin, a bull-shouldered defenceman whose inability to skate was the chief justification for the nickname of Ivan the Terrible.

Irwin was packed off to Providence. But the fan club, entranced by his occasional collisions with incoming forwards and reminded by his sparse head of hair of Ching Johnson, demanded the return of the man they saw as the reincarnation of the most illustrious Ranger defenceman of the past.
"Bring back Ivan," the allergy signs demanded.
Late last season, Watson obliged. Irwin took the ice amid deafening cheers, waved at the crowd, waved at a passing forward who went around him smoothly to score, and returned to the bench. Despite the signs, his next trip to Providence was permanent.

This year the undaunted fans repeated the process on Murphy's behalf when Watson sent him down early in the season, claiming he was out of condition. You just can't do a thing like that to an Irishman in New York.
Now Murphy is back to bolster a club that is scrambling for fourth place mainly because of a lack of scoring punch. The chances are that Watson wouldn't mind if the fans won the argument this time.

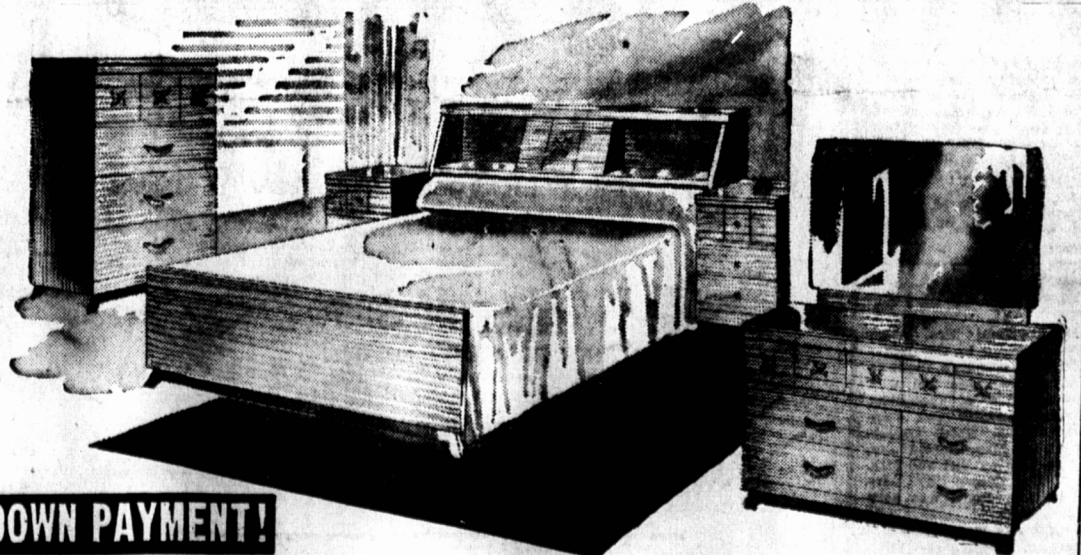

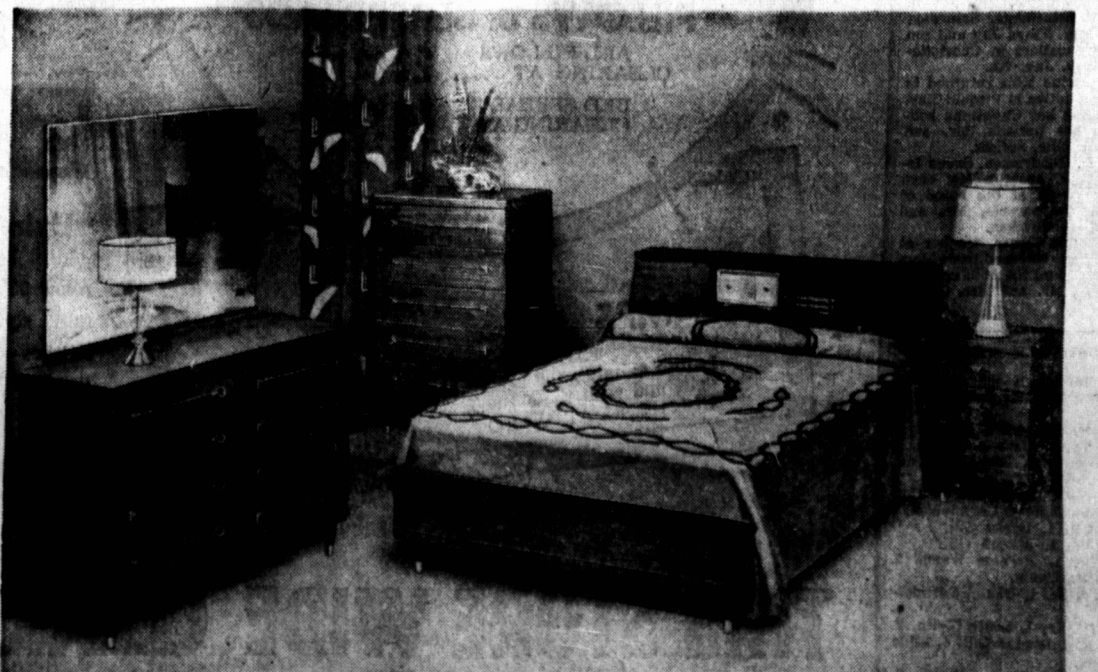
