#### TORONTO MAR-TIN GRUDE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS IN LAW

This scholarship, tenable at UNB, will be awarded to a student or students from the Atlantic Provinces who have been accepted into first-year law. This scholarship is awarded on the basis of demonstrated academic ability as well as wide participation in community and extra-curricular activities. The award is valued at full tuition. #### THE LAW FOUNDATION OF BRITISH COLUMBIA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Four scholarships val-

ued at \$4,500 each are available for students entering their first year of law at University of Victoria. Qualifications for these scholarships include Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status, outstanding pre-law academic record and other qualities needed for the attainment of distinction in the legal profession.

#### LAW SOCIETY OF P.E.I. SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to any Island student either studying or intending to study law. Applications should include curriculum vitae transcript (full year or more of law or last three year's courses including course description). Also, please include any other courses or qualification that are relevant.

#### MR. JUSTICE MARK R. MACGUIGAN MEMORIAL BURSARY

This bursary, valued at \$500, is available to Island students pursuing graduate or professional studies especially in the area of law. All inquiries applications is normally in July.

#### LEGAL STUDIES FOR ABORIGINAL PEOPLE

Students should keep in mind that many law schools have other bursary and scholarship programs which do not involve special application procedures. Ten scholarships are available to Metis and non-status Indian students interested in attending law school.
