The bidding: North East South West Pass 1 ♠ 4 ♠ 4 ♠ 4

Opening lead—queen of spades. This hand is reported as it was played in a recent national championship. By no stretch of the imagination was it representative of the level of skill usually found in championship tournaments.

East's double of five hearts is difficult to explain. Although it is true five spades could not be made, East had every reason to expect the value from West that would produce eleven tricks.

The four players at the table were all well-known experts. East's playing was hardly consistent with his reputation, but South's play, which were coming in worse.
