SPANISH VICTORIES.

Cubans Meet With Reverses— Feeling Against the United States.

HAVANA, March 30.—Col. Molina reports the capture of a rebel camp at Guaimal, near Corral Falso, province of Matanzas. The troops attacked the camp with machine guns and the rebels fled, leaving 35 dead.

A military strong line has been established from Matanzas, on the south coast, to Matuel, on the north coast, extending across the narrowest part of the island. The line separates the provinces of Havana and Pinar del Rio.
