Sir:—In the Patriot yesterday Mr. Farquharson tries to get out of the awkward position in which he finds himself. The facts are that he was not a candidate for West Queens when in Ottawa last spring, and he positively refused to run after his return. Let no one suppose however that Mr. Farquharson was idle. The question of a suitable representative, not of West Queens, but of Mr. Farquharson at Ottawa was receiving his best attention. As his plans developed the name of a young lawyer was put forward and the party in question was feeling his way among the Liberals of the constituency. It would indeed be a shame if this great farming and commercial riding was represented at Ottawa by a young and inexperienced lawyer, who knew nothing whatever of the interests committed to his charge. But these considerations did not weigh with Mr. Farquharson. Leader of the local Government and with an obedient follower at Ottawa, the patronage of two Governments would be in his hands. The prospect was most encouraging.  
But the best laid schemes of mice and men sometimes fail. At this juncture many Liberals, satisfied that West Queens should have an able and experienced man of affairs at Ottawa, approached Mr. Hazzard and secured his consent to run. At once all was uproar in Mr. Farquharson's camp. A vigorous determined representative at Ottawa would not suit him at all. Rather than see all his plans upset he must take the field himself. His decision came too late. It is not often that a business man of Mr. Hazzard's standing and character will consent to go into politics, but it is the services of just such men this great Dominion wants. Therefore the Liberals of West Queens are determined to send Mr. Hazzard to Ottawa.
