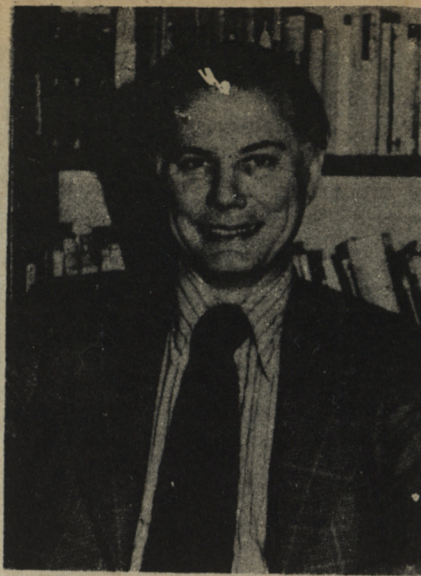
Union would like to organize & carry out activities in both of these fields. A Chairman is needed for both as well as a number of interested students.
