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of proven safety devices in all new cars.

Joseph Keeler, president of the 25,000-member group, told the U.S. House of Representatives committee:

"On the basis of our experience, we believe 50 per cent of all fatalities would be eliminated by mandating the known safety features into the design of all new automobiles."

Among these, Keeler listed collapsible steering wheels, energy-absorbing front and rear bumpers, shatterproof safety glass that could "pop out" on impact of the passenger, interior padding and head restraints to prevent whiplash injuries.

"It is undeniable," he said, "that the automobile industry has dragged its feet in the conception and production of safer automobiles to guard the lives of our people."

Keeler said of the auto industry's plea for more time to conduct research: "This committee must approach the problem of proposed research with sophistication and realization that the requirements of research before the changes are mandated will be an indulgence in the waiting game while thousands of Americans will die and millions will be injured needlessly."

The U.S. administration's bill being considered by the committee would authorize the commerce secretary to set standards in two years if he finds it necessary.

Attorney General Lawrence F. Scalia of Iowa told the committee he had invited industry spokesmen to attend a safety meeting this office held last January "to tell the people of Iowa what they are doing to make automobiles safer."

"They chose not to appear," he said. "They chose to send an industry lobbyist who had no

technical background and who refused to talk about the very subject of the hearing... the safety of automobiles and the safety policies of the automobile companies."

### DEMANDS LEGISLATION

Scalia called for "legislation that will compel the automobile industry to place on the public record copies of their directives to dealers in respect to repairs or modifications necessary to correct defects where those defects relate to the safety of automobile occupants."

The committee spent the morning questioning Teamsters President James R. Hoffa, who testified in favor of mandatory federal safety standards covering "all phases of transportation," including all trucks.

Hoffa said he favors establishment of a government agency to inspect motor vehicles for safety violations in the way that the Federal Aviation Agency inspects civil aircraft.

Hoffa supported truck inspection by the federal government, possibly at stations along interstate highways, with the federal and state governments sharing inspection of vehicles—but under federal standards.

### Gromyko Meets Pope Paul

Rome (Reuters)—Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko emerged from a historic discussion with Pope Paul and called for a meeting among the leaders of Europe.

He said the conference should be at the highest level possible and its subject should be the security of Europe. But he hinted that the United States should not be invited.

## Antibiotic Testing On Cancer Described As Routine Matter

REGINA (CP)—A new antibiotic developed by Canadian agricultural scientists in Ottawa is being tested against cancer as a matter of routine. Dr. J. F. Morgan of Saskatoon said here.

Dr. Morgan, head of the University of Saskatchewan's cancer research department, said new drug, called myxin, may be a cancer cure should be avoided.

"There is no indication there is more likelihood this will work against cancer than any of the other materials have. But it is important to test against cancer."

Dr. Morgan said the three scientists who developed myxin sent him a small amount of it more than a year ago and asked him to perform some tests.

"There was not enough for conclusive tests and the first small sample was not too pure. But mice with cancer did tolerate it," Dr. Morgan said. Recently he received a larger sample.

**CONTRACT BRIDGE**

You are declarer with the West hand at Four Hearts, North having opened the bidding with a diamond which East doubled. North leads the king of clubs. How would you play the hand?

1. Obviously you must take the king of spades because there is the grave danger of a club shift which might defeat you. The next play should be a low diamond to the ace. This is a safety play to guard against the possibility of South's having all four missing diamonds. If it turns out that the diamonds are divided 2-2 or 3-1, you are certain of being able to cash ten tricks. It is only when the diamonds are divided 4-0 that the contract is in danger. If North had the J-10-8-4, it makes no difference whether your first lead is the king or the six. In either case north has the suit stopped.

2. But, if South has the J-10-8-4, leading low to the ace prevents him from ever winning a diamond trick. Let's suppose that North shows out on the first lead. In that case you return a diamond and win the ten with the queen. Then you enter dummy with a heart and play another diamond, trapping the J-8 with your K-9.

The effect of the safety play is that you win a spade, four hearts and four diamonds to make the contract.
