



PROBABLE INTERNATIONAL DAM SITE

The international Columbia River engineering board has proposed development of the Columbia River with the building of at least eight power dams in British Columbia costing up to \$1,000,000,000. This week the International Joint Commission meets in Washington to discuss the proposal and figure how the benefits will be shared between Canada and the United States. This photo, released at Ottawa by the water resources branch of the department of northern affairs shows the site of a proposed dam at Dorr on the Kootenay River 10 miles north of the international boundary. One proposal is to build a dam at Dorr, diverting the Kootenay into the Columbia. The photo, carries the engineers' marks showing the flood line which outlines the upstream area to be flooded when the dam is built. The axis indicates the top level of the water at the dam. Bar Belle from the herd of Willard Lank West Royalty led Canada for milk and butterfat production in the eight-year-old class in 1958. She produced 10258 pounds milk and 419 pounds butterfat in 333 days.
Clover Sis also from the Lank herd is the Canadian leader of the 10-year-old class for the first two months of 1959. She produced 8368 pounds milk and 370 pounds fat in 346 days. It is interesting to note that Clover Sis had the highest butterfat production for Red Polls in Canada for all classes in 1955 and was winner of the Agnes McComb Memorial Trophy that year when she produced 10736 pounds milk and 519 pounds fat.
The Lank herd also had the highest average butterfat test for 1958 with an average of 4.23% per cent.
