SPRING FLOCKS

Do not imagine that every Crow heard and every Robin seen from the first of January until now is an early migrant, because individuals of these and several other species remain in Canada all winter.

Most species travel in darkness, so are seldom "caught in the act" of returning, unless we obtain a view of them flying across the face of the moon, or are able to recognize them by their voices, as we do the Canada Goose.

Once April has begun, birds arrive thick and fast. Grackles, several kinds of Ducks, Killdeers, Tree Swallows (sometimes in flocks numbering 500), and Fox Sparrows are hurrying forward.

The arrival date of migrants is so regular that, unless there are very unusual weather conditions, we can foretell within a very few days when each species is due to return.

Socialist Peers Give Aristocracy Fresh Injection

LONDON, March 22 (AP) - A peer in Britain these days has to be pretty smart, or pretty lucky, if he doesn't want to end up a pauper.

Inheriting a title isn't what it used to be, what with death duties swallowing up most of the cash and land that goes with it.

During the Labor regime nearly 80 peers were created - and about three-quarters of them have heirs.

Not Ancient

The peerage isn't as old as the hills - in fact most titles were created in the last 50 years.

Coats of arms are complicated and expensive. They cost about £105 and are designed by the Royal College of Heraldry - set up in the days when every knight and nobleman wore his badge to identify himself on the field of battle.

Families who for centuries have been landowners are turning to commerce to get their living. Castles and granges are getting too expensive to keep up in these days of rising prices.

The settings won't be the same, of course. More and more of the stately homes of Britain are going under the auctioneer's hammer and their former owners are moving into modest flats or city houses.

Commission To Probe Brutal Ritual Murders

MBABANE, Swaziland, March 22 (Reuters) - African chiefs will be among members of a commission set up by the administration today to investigate the growth of brutal ritual murders in this tiny British protectorate.

Ritual murders are on the increase among the 180,000 Africans in Swaziland, A.C. Thompson, attorney-general for African territories, warned.

Ritual murders are committed mainly to obtain parts of the victim's body which—according to ancient superstitions—contain special properties. Adolescent youths and women recently confined or pregnant are popular victims.

Flesh cut from the body is handed to unscrupulous which doctors who concoct "medicine" to bring fertility to barren women, rejuvenation of aged chieftains, added strength in legal squabbles, better crops and cures for illness.
