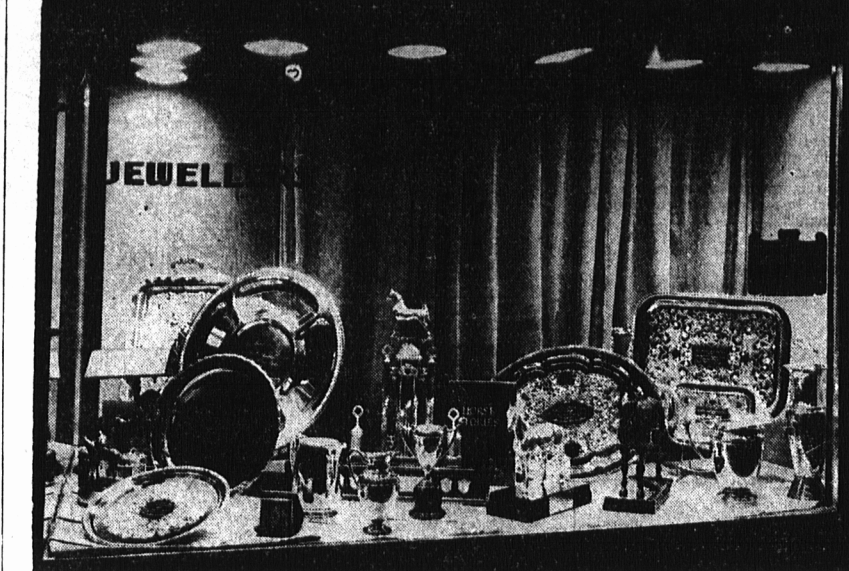

LONDON, Nov. 2 - (Reuters) - A new act, revising Britain's 60-year-old libel and slander laws to protect authors and publishers won a race against the clock in parliament Wednesday.

U.S. Investors Disposing Of Canadian Securities

OTTAWA, Nov. 2 - (CP) - Many United States investors in Canadian securities are disposing of their holdings in such Canadian developments as oil drilling, mining and manufacturing is still heavy and officials said is currently running at just below the rate of \$800,000,000 a year net inflow achieved in 1951.

Reason for the reversal, officials said, is that many American investors purchased Canadian bonds and stocks at a time when the Canadian dollar was under par. With the dollar now well above par, they are disposing of their holdings in Canadian markets and turning their Canadian dollars into bigger amounts of American currency.

This means a heavy movement of capital out of Canada. But securities transactions form only part of total capital movement. Direct investment in such Canadian developments as oil drilling, mining and manufacturing is still heavy and officials said is currently running at just below the rate of \$800,000,000 a year net inflow achieved in 1951.

Finance Minister Abbott referred to capital movement in a speech before the Vancouver Board of Trade last Monday and said:

"My impression is that on balance, the sum total of all kinds of capital transactions this year may show, if anything, some net outflow of capital."

The bill makes broadcast defamatory statements actionable as

libel instead of slander. The law of slander is more lax than the law of libel, because the spoken word has a narrower circulation than the written.

But the development of broadcasting means, in the words of one expert, "mud can be flung round the world with the speed of light."

The only clause holding up the bill today was one which the House of Lords wanted retained and the House of Commons wanted deleted.

This allowed newspapers to plead qualified privilege in reporting statements made in foreign parliaments which might turn out to be defamatory.

This would have meant that if the President of the United States called a British cabinet minister a liar any British newspaper reporting the fact could be sued for libel.
