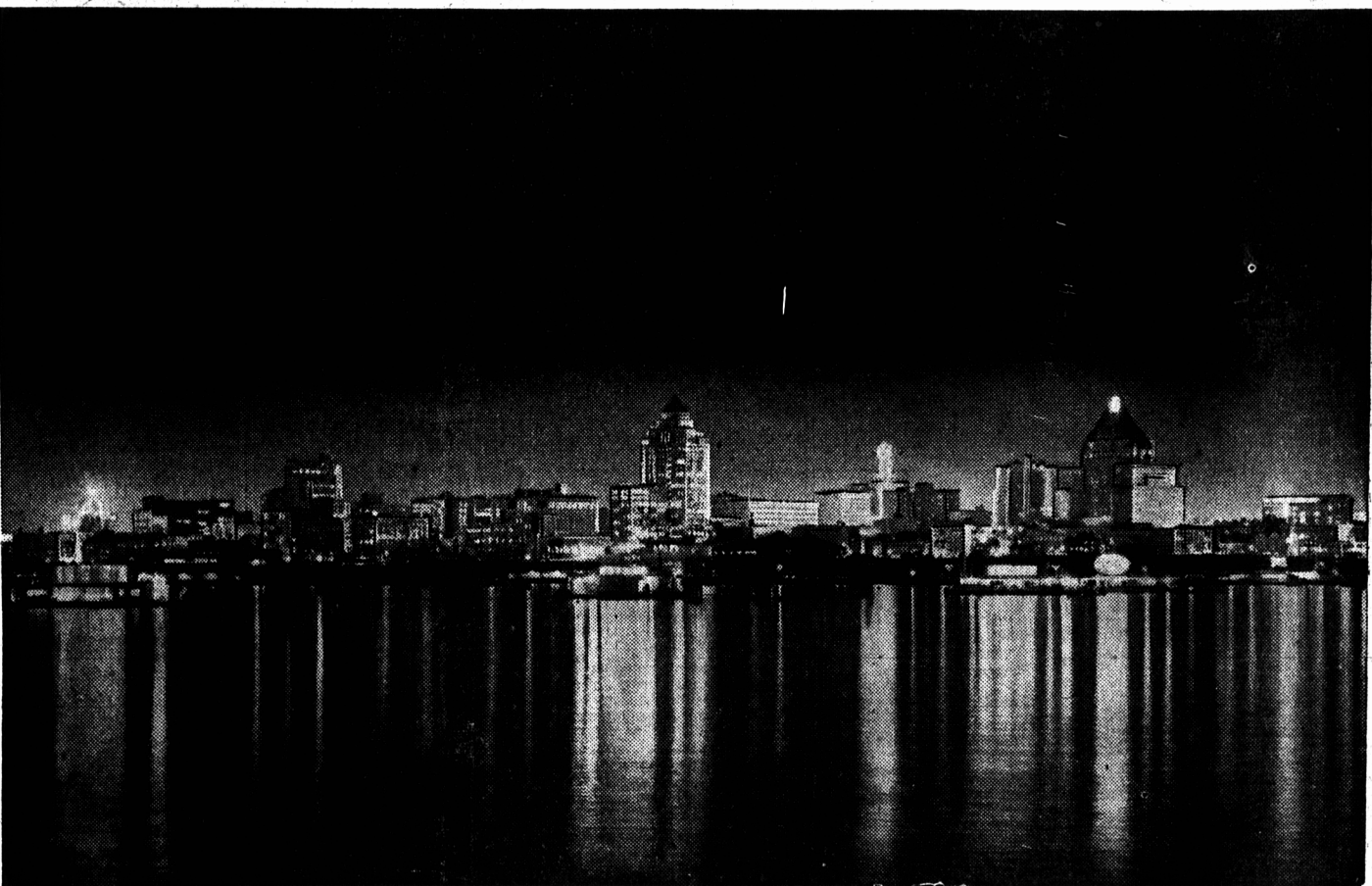
Yankee Hanover May Be Retired
