**More Control Suggested On New Flag Use**

OTTAWA (CP)—Prime Minister Pearson said here he thinks consideration should be given to legislation controlling the use made of the maple leaf flag.

He was commenting at the request of J. Chester MacRae (PC—York-Sunbury) who drew his attention to a Canadian Press photo of a maple leaf flag design being used as an awning at a meat market.

Mr. Pearson said in light of this and other similar situations brought to his attention he thinks legislation governing use of the flag should be considered.

**INVESTIGATE MONTREALER**  
GLASGOW (CP)—The search has switched to Canada for an armed bandit who held up a Scottish bank Dec. 19 and escaped with £3,000 (\$9,000). Police here want to interview an unidentified man who flew into Prestwick from Montreal on the day of the robbery and is believed to have flown back to Canada the next day.

**Claims By Foundation Classed As Nonsense**

TORONTO (CP)—A belief by the international foundation for the holy shroud, with headquarters in London, that Christ merely fainted and didn't die on the cross was called nonsense here.

Spokesmen for the United Church of Canada, the Presbyterian church in Canada, the Anglican Church of Canada and the Roman Catholic church all said Christ literally died and later rose from the dead.

Earlier this week, Dr. J. G. Bourne, a senior anesthetist at a London hospital, said Christ merely fainted on the cross and later recovered from a coma.

He based his opinion on investigations of patients who fainted under general anesthesia while in dentists' chairs.

The foundation had several photographs taken of a shroud kept in the Roman Catholic cathedral in Turin, Italy, which many Christians believe covered Christ's body after it was taken from the cross at calvary.

The foundation said the shroud acted as a photographic negative to show blood stains from Christ's wounds. But it added that if he had been dead, there would have been no blood stains because a corpse has no blood pressure.

**THEORY NOT NEW**

Rev. Earl Lautenschlager, principal of the United Church's Emmanuel Theological College, said the foundation's theory "has been mentioned by people of every generation since the first century AD."

"All we know is what is written in the Scriptures. It's the Scriptures. It's the only evidence."

Rt. Rev. G. B. Snell, Anglican coadjutor bishop of Toronto, wondered why anyone should doubt the authenticity of Christ's death and resurrection.

"I would rather accept the word of eye witnesses than speculation 2,000 years later," he said.

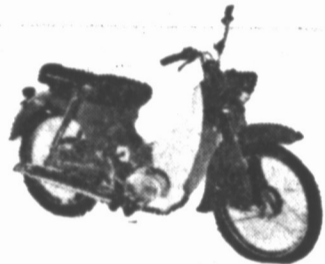
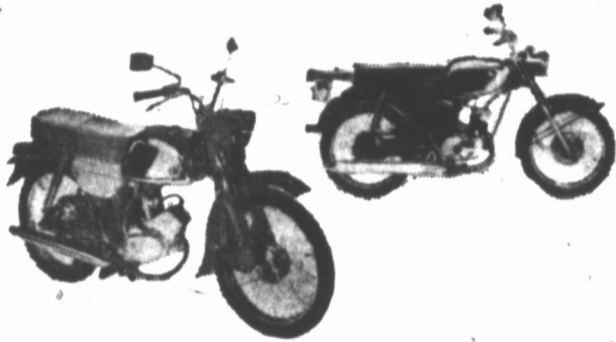
Rev. Frank Stone, director of the Catholic Information Centre, said the foundation's theory is "shot down by the fact that it doesn't explain why the Christian community should have such a solid belief in the resurrection."

Rev. Allan Farris, professor of theology at Knox Presbyterian college, said: "We have to take evidence from the only documents available—the Gospels."

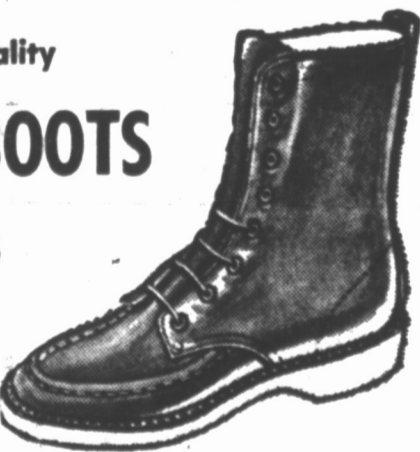
