There are 7,000 men at work on the Lessep Panama canal.

India now has 10,241 miles of railroad, and 3072 miles more are in course of construction or projected.

A farmer in Clark county, Ind., works a farm of 1,500 acres, which he owns, without leaving either to read or write.

The Queen has intimated her intention of opening the Fisheries Exhibition even if unable to walk at the time of opening.

It is expected in Montreal that the number of immigrants at the close of this season will be twice the number that arrived last year.

An Ottawa correspondent writes that Hon. Dr. Parker, a member of the Legislative Council, Nova Scotia, is likely to succeed His Honor Lieut. Governor Archibald.

The action of Mr. Gordon Brown against the Globe Printing Company for \$5,000 damages, for wrongful dismissal, has been settled by the defendant's agreeing to pay Mr. Brown \$2,500 and his law costs of \$200, in all \$2,700.

The House of Commons on Monday as an additional mark of recognition of the services of Lord Wolsley and Baron Alcester (Admiral Seymour) in the war in Egypt, passed a vote granting them £2,000 each yearly, which, at their death, shall revert to their next heirs.

The sword of John Hampden has been sold at auction in London for 58 guineas. It is the sword he wore during the civil war, and in a long rapier with a cross hilt and scroll guard. It was made in Germany, and had always been in the possession of the Hampden family, when in 1861 a second John Hampden died leaving the sword among his possessions. His brother, the Bishop of Hereford, then ordered that it be sold. It fell into the possession of a Mr. Robinson, who had often seen this John Hampden point to the sword proudly, saying:—'This is the sword of John Hampden, my great ancestor. Mr. Robinson gave it to a Mr. Friswell who recently died, and with whose effects it has now been sold.'
