Death Toll Among World Figures During The Year

The death of Andrei Vishinsky in 1954's closing weeks ended the career of one of the chief figures in the cold war. Moscow's mouthpiece at the United Nations, Vishinsky slumped dead at his desk Nov. 22 while working on a speech he was to have delivered that day to the UN general assembly in New York. He was 70.

Vishinsky made his name as prosecutor at the sensational Moscow purge trials in the 1930's which sent to their death Soviet leaders who had earned Stalin's enmity. Vishinsky went on to become a leading Soviet agent in the enslavement of the Baltic countries and Romania. At the UN he was noted for his skill in debate and his vitriolic tirades against the West.

The year brought death also to other world leaders. Alcide de Gasperi, 73, Premier of Italy's first post-war government who aligned his country firmly with the West, died Aug. 10. Viscount Simon, former British foreign secretary, died Jan. 11 at 80. Viscount Norwich, 63, better known as Alfred Duff Cooper, member of Winston Churchill's wartime government, died at sea New Year's Day.

The world of art lost Henri Matisse, the French painter, who died Nov. 3 at 84. Lionel Barrymore, noted member of a noted stage family, died in California Nov. 15. Other stage and screen personalities who died during the year were Mr. Sydney Greenstreet, 74, fat man villain of a movie; John Murray Anderson, Newfoundland-born stage producer; Frederick Londale, 73, British playwright.

Oscar Strauss, composer of the "Chocolate Soldier" and other Viennese waltzes, died Jan. 1 at 83. Colet, the French novelist, died Sept. 3. She was 81. Emmeline Lady Pethick-Lawrence, 8, prominent in the British suffragette movement early in the century, died March 11.

Two noted cartoonists died within two weeks of each other. Bud Fisher, 69, creator of Mutt and Jeff, died Sept. 7, shortly before the death of George McManus, 70, from whose pencil came the widely-known Jiggs and Maggie comic strip.

In the newspaper field, Lord Camrose, 74, publisher of the London Daily Telegraph, died June 15. Death cut short at the age of 43 the career of Eric Gibbs, Edmonton-born newspaper man who was the Paris correspondent of "Time" and "Life" magazines. Grantland Rice, 73, dean of American sports writers, died July 13.

Dr. W. R. Inge, the former "Gloomy Dean" of St. Paul's in London, died Feb. 26 at 83. Dr. Hugo Eckener, 86, the zeppelin expert, died Aug. 14. An outstanding scientist of the atom age, Dr. Karl Compton, died Aug. 14. Gen. Hoyt Vandenberg, youthful - appearing chief of the U. S. air force, was the victim of cancer at 55. Leon Jouhaux, 74, French labor leader, died April 28.

The year brought the death of a onetime slave in the southern U. S. who was believed to have been the second oldest person in the world. Clem Uncle Pike Noble was reputed to be 123. A man one year older is said to be alive in Indonesia, Britain's oldest woman, Mrs. Julia Gray, 107, died Dec. 1. Walter E. Scott, 81, California's "Death Valley Scotty," died Jan. 6. A man who spent 18 years in an iron lung following a polio attack, Fred Snite Jr., died Nov. 12 at 44.

Lillian Mary Bayliss, famous English theatrical manager who died in 1937, began her career as a child violinist.
