A REASONED OPINION.

But it shall always be provided that a majority of the ratepayers of any district or portion of the Northwest Territories or any lesser portion or subdivision thereof by whatever name the same may be known, may establish such schools therein as they may think fit, and make the necessary assessments and collections of rates therefor and further, that the minority of the ratepayers, whether Protestant or Roman Catholic may establish separate schools therein in such latter case, the ratepayers establishing such Protestant or Roman Catholic schools shall be liable only to the assessments of such schools as they may impose upon themselves in respect thereof.

In 1883 he was appointed High Commissioner to the Court of St. James, London, but in 1887 he was at Sir John's side in the election of that year, and the terror of Tupper's name was increased in the minds of his opponents.
