MONTREAL (CP) - United States dollar in terms of Canadian funds down 1-16 at \$1.07 19-32. Pound sterling down 3-16 at \$3.00 1/4.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - Steels steadied in a mixed and cautious stock market Monday as President Johnson brought his influence to bear on the deadlocked negotiators in the steel-labor dispute.

The Dow Jones industrial average took a trivial loss of 33 at 895.63. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks closed unchanged at 33.1 with industrials off 1/8, rails off 2 and utilities up 1/8.

U.S. steel ended the day with a loss of 1/8 at 50 1/2 but it sold as high as 50 1/2. Jones and Laughlin rose 1/8, Lukens 1/8, Republic Steel 1/8 and Bethlehem 1/8.

Among Canadian issues Canadian Javelin rose 1/8, Scurry Rainbow Oil and Brazilian Tractor 1/8, Molybdenite 1-16. Preston lost 1/4, Canadian Marconi 1/8.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - Utilities were lower and against the general trend Monday on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. Trading was active.

Industrial volume was 95,000 shares and mines and oils 1,594,900. The composite index was up 1/2 to 154.87.

Industrials were up 0.24 to 160.25. Asbestos dropped 1/4 to 85 and Canada Cement 1/4 to 55.

Banks were up 0.67 to 124.25. Royal added one point to 77 and Nova Scotia 1/2 to 73 1/2. Provincial rose 1/2 to 51 1/2.

Papers were up 0.02 to 123.55. Great Lakes added 1/4 to 24 1/4 and Dominion Tr 1/4 to 19 1/2. Fraser lost 1/4 to 31 1/4.

Utilities were off 0.51 at 150.16. BC Telephone fell 1/4 to 64 1/2 and Bell Telephone 1/4 to 58 1/4. Quebec Natural Gas was off 1/4 at 10 1/4 and CPR added 1/4 to 66.

In senior oils Imperial climbed 1/4 to 54 1/4, BA dropped 1/4 to 29 1/4 and Husky 1/4 to 12. Metals were mixed. In base issues Noranda fell 1/4 to 48 1/4 and Hollinger was up 1/4 to 28 1/4.

In the primaries, Algoma rose 1/4 to 64 1/4 and Dominion Foundries 1/4 to 27 1/2. Steel of Canada added 1/4 to 29.

Machinery issues were ahead with Massey Ferguson up 1/4 to 31 1/4 and Hawker Siddley off 1/4 to 5 1/4.

Among speculative mines, Dolan added six cents to 90 cents with a turnover of 693,550 shares. Midex was up five cents to \$3.25 and inspiration off 15 cents at \$1.60. Jubilee iron dropped 10 cents to \$4.15 and Black Hawk five cents to \$2.71.

TORONTO TORONTO (CP) - Stocks were mixed and price changes mostly fractional on light trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange Monday.

The industrial index, a measurement of investors' confidence and participation in the market, climbed 0.5 to 165.20. Union Carbide had the best gain, up 1 1/2 to 39 1/2. Royal Bank climbed 1/4 to 77 while Massey Ferguson tacked on 1/4 at 31 1/4.

Bank of Nova Scotia 20 1/2 to 73 1/2, Bank of Montreal fell 1/4 to 61 1/2 and Toronto-Dominion 1/4 to 60 1/2.

Gunnar Mining fell 34 cents to \$1.91 in active dealings. A report on the company's financial is expected soon. The report was requested last week by the exchange after the company's stock fell sharply and Gunnar management said that its construction division, McNamara Corp., was in financial trouble.

Senior base metals took a small loss, due chiefly to setbacks of 1/2 to Inco at 93 1/2 and Hudson Bay at 67 1/2. Denison climbed 1/4 to 33 1/2 and its affiliated company, Roghan Corp., 30 cents to \$7.30. United Kenn Hill, a sharp loser last week, recovered 20 cents to \$6.10.
