Notice to Commercial Travellers. The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the following sections of an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly of Prince Edward Island, Session 1894.

From and after the passing of this Act every casual trader not permanently residing in the Province, commonly known as "Commercial Travellers" and every person permanently residing in this Province, who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise in any Province, or solicits or canvasses for orders either for himself or any other person, or for the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, or stamp by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he or she enters upon the business of so selling any goods, wares or merchandise, or soliciting or canvassing for orders, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province an annual license fee of two dollars.
