Increased Entries in PEI Drama Festival

An increase in entries over last year was shown at a meeting of the executive of the Provincial Drama Festival, held in Charlottetown on April 10.

The President, Mr. Daniel MacDonald of St. Peter's, was in the chair, and reports were heard from the various committees on arrangements being made for the play-offs, and the finals which will be held the last week of May.

Miss Jessie Fraser, Summerside, secretary-treasurer, read the list of entries which showed six three-act plays and seven one-act in the senior play-offs, and a possible four plays in the junior competition.

The convener of the adjudicating committee, Mrs. M. F. Rodd of St. Amand's, announced that Professor Alvin J. Shaw of the University of New Brunswick, had consented to adjudicate the finals, and local adjudicators for the play-offs were named: Harrington W. I. entry of "Uncle Josh Perkins," of Summerside.

Of Debentures by the City of Charlottetown for the Board of School Trustees of Charlottetown an Act for Appropriating Certain Monies therein mentioned for the Public Service for the Fiscal Year ending 31st March, 1955 and for the first part of the year ending 31st March, 1956.

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Competition in the rural three-act class will be especially keen with entries including communities at opposite ends of the Province. The four entries in this class are the Tignish Players, with their entry of "The Light Eternal," directed by Rev. Denis Gallant; Indian River with "Tempest and Sunshine," directed by Rev. Louis Callaghan; Bedouin Players with "The Calamity Kids," directed by Phyllis Britten, and "Busy Honey-moon," by the Souris Players, directed by Melvin McQuaid.

Summerside has entered the City three-act competition for the first time, and the Sum-Hi Dramatic Players will put their "Apron Strings," written and directed by Norman MacDonald, into competition with the Charlottetown Little Theatre's production of "Summer Day's Dream," directed by Hazel Hunter.

Entered in one-act classes are St. Peter's A.Y.P.A., Charlottetown, with "This Night Shall Pass," directed by Stuart Dickson; "To What Purpose," by the Charlottetown Little Theatre Guild, directed by Cecilia Blatch; Two entries by Trinity United Y. P. U. of Summerside, "A Ghostly Evening," directed by Wm. Moase, and "Five to Five-Thirty," directed by Estelle Bowness; Trinity Y.P.U. of Montague with "The Feminine Touch," directed by Gilbert Clements and directed by Mrs. A. E. Phillips, and "The Shadow of a Dream," pro-

duced by Kelvin Grove Dramatic Group and directed by Mrs Harold Laird.

In the junior competition Grade V of Spring Park have entered "Robin Hood," directed by Winnifred MacLeod, and West Royalty School has entered "Hans Brinker and the Silver Skates," directed by Wanda Murphy. Two other schools have also signified their intention of entering plays.

The meeting also decided that because of a misunderstanding as to the closing date entries in all classes would be accepted a few more days.

The next meeting of the executive will be held April 21, at the Y.M.C.A.

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
