

Hillsborough River on ice near Bridge on Feb. 15 (BBa); 2 adults on ice downstream of Hillsborough Bridge with one doing neck stretch displays to the other and then doing a short hop flight over the other (repeated five times) on Feb. 15 (JDM); 1 at Tryon Mar. 12 (BeH); 1 at Cherry Hill on Mar. 16 (DW); 1 at Mount Herbert on Mar. 19 (MK); 1 immature at Hillsborough Bridge on the ice on Mar. 25 (BH); *Gray Partridge* - 18 at Elliotvale on Feb. 1 (JDM); 5 at Johnsons River on Mar. 5 (JDM); *Glaucous Gull* - 4 at Ellen's Creek on Feb. 24 (RC); 1 at Charlottetown on Mar. 13 (SM, JB); *Iceland Gull* - 2 at West Royalty throughout Jan and early February (JDM); 3 at Belvedere Pond on Feb. 6 (SM, JB); 20 at Borden on Feb. 21 (JDM); 14 Kumlein's and 2 nominate at Ellen's Creek on Mar. 20 (SM, JB, JDM); *Lesser Black-backed Gull* - 1 at Ellen's Creek on Mar. 3 (RC); *Black Guillemot* - 5 off Panmure Island on Mar. 21 (JDM, RC); *Mourning Doves* - 1 at York feeder over Christmas (JtR); 1 at Stanley Bridge Feeder on Feb. 6 (JB, MaR); 1 to 47 at East Royalty feeder from Jan. 1 to Mar. 4 (C&MW); *Great-horned Owl* - 1 calling at Springvale on Jan. 11 (SS); *Snowy Owl* - 1 at Lockeshore Road between Jan. 16 & Feb. 14 (LH); 1 had to be chased of Charlottetown airport runway (RP); 1 at Summerside on Mar. 27 (PA); *Barred Owl* - 2 at calling at DeSable Marsh on Feb. 28 (BP); *Belted Kingfisher* - 1 at Sleepy Hollow on Mar. 13 (EC); 1 at Cardigan Bridge on Mar. 20 (GeM); 1 at Marshall's Pond on Mar. 24 (FC); *Red-bellied Woodpecker* - 1 male still at Stanley Bridge feeder, carrying and storing dog food pellets in holes in snag like trees and poles until Feb. 27 (W&JM, JDM, SM, JB); *Northern Flicker* - 1 male at Desable feeder on Feb. 17 (RM); 1 at Panmure Island on side of leader of 3 meter white spruce and 1 at Lower Montague on Mar. 21 (JDM, RC); *Horned Lark* - 12+ at Lockeshore Road on Jan. 17 (LH); 12 at West Cape on Feb. 25 (GeM); 16 at Charlottetown Airport with 3 Snow Buntings on Mar. 10 (RP); *Gray Jay* - 2 at Monticello and 1 at Cardross on Mar. 13 (GeM); *Blue Jay* - in tree tops giving comb call at Vernon Bridge on Mar. 21 (RC, JDM); *Red-breasted Nuthatch* - 1 at Tryon in Mar. (BeH); *American Robin* - 1 at Sherwood on Mar. 12 (RC); *Bohemian Waxwing* - 53 at West Royalty on Feb. 24 (EC); 26 at Sleepy Hollow on Mar. 7 (EC); *Cedar Waxwing* - 15 at Charlottetown on Feb. 21 (RC); 12 at Crossroads on Mar. 14 (DW); *Northern Shrike* - 1 hunted through conifer hedge beside South Granville feeder on Feb. 7 (MaR); 1 at Poverty Beach and 1 at High Bank on Mar. 21 (RC, JDM); *Common Grackle* - 1 at Charlottetown on Feb. 25 (GeM); 5 at Sherwood on Mar. 10 (RC); 1 at Sleepy Hollow on Mar. 24 (BB); *Pine Siskin* - 2 at Montague feeder in Feb. (GB); very few sightings this winter to date; *Evening Grosbeak* - 20 in single flock at Little York over Christmas (JtR); *Pine Grosbeak* - 8 to 10 males and females at Summerside on Jan. 26; 16 to 20 Feb. & Mar. 12 at Tryon (BeH); 1 pair at East Royalty in Feb. & Mar. feeding on ash seed (C&MW); 2 males and 2 females at Monticello on Feb. 17 (GeM); *European Goldfinch* - 1 still at South Granville on Feb. 6 (MaR) but flew away to Pinsent feeder about 2 kilometers north when a large gray hawk made a swing by the feeder (MaR, MP); *American Goldfinch* - 24 - 30 at Springvale feeder on niger seed (SS); *Northern Junco* - about 20 daily at Springvale feeder from Dec. - Feb. (SS); 6 daily at York feeder in Feb. (JtR); 8 to 10 at Montague feeder in Feb. (GB); *American Tree Sparrow* - 1 at Brackley Beach on Feb. 5 (EC); several at Malpeque on Feb. 14 (LH); 3 at Donagh feeder in Mar. (JDM); *White-throated Sparrow* - 1 immature at York feeder Dec. - Feb. (JtR); *Song Sparrows* - 2 at York feeder daily in Jan. - Feb. (JtR); 2 at Tryon feeder in Feb. (BeH) 2 at Malpeque on Feb. 14 (LH); 1 singing at Pownall on Mar. 21 (RC); *Lapland Longspur* - 19 at Graham's Pond in Feb. (VM, GJ); *Snow Bunting* - first at feeder on Jan. 27 (SS); 40 to 60 at Graham's Pond Mar. 5 - 11 (VM, GJ); 36 - 48 at Stanhope feeder in February (EM). Older Reports: *Northern Mockingbird* at St. Charles in summer of 1992 (SF); 7 *Red-throated Loons* at Sea Cow Light in September/92 (RJM, LH, JH); and FC reported a decline in Northern Harriers at Covehead in 1992 as well as a general decline in small birds at feeder this winter (down from 200 to 300 per day to 40 to 50 per day)
