French Commander At Dien Bien Phu Is Promoted; Had Threatened To Quit

PARIS. (Reuters)—Col. Christian de Castries, whose troops have held the besieged fortress of Dien Bien Phu in northern Indo-China for five months against Communist rebel attacks, was promoted Friday to brigadier-general.

The announcement followed reports that the dashing 50-year-old career soldier had threatened to resign because of insufficient reinforcements and the delay in making his promotion official.

De Castries, tall, rugged, former cavalry officer who won the world riding championship in 1931, has directed his forces in throwing back every assault the Communists have hurled against the fortress.

Last month President Eisenhower described him as a "very brilliant young colonel" and said that if he were his commander he would make de Castries a general.

The promotion was subsequently recommended but was not made official by the French cabinet. At the time it was announced it was being held up because of French tradition that promotion is not granted until the battle in which the officer is engaged is completed.

Eisenhower Makes. Eisenhower made a pledge, although he said the essential elements of his position had been discussed with both Republican and Democratic leaders.

May Be Major Debate. Senator Mike Mansfield (Dem. Mont.) forswore a possible "great debate" rivaling the one three years ago over President Truman's decision to send troops to Europe.

President's Pledge. The president promised that when EDC comes into being the United States will: 1. Keep in Europe, including Germany, whatever number of U.S. troops are needed to make up a "fair share" of the forces required for Western defence.

Some Big Ones Taken Opening Day Near Montague

The silence of the early hours of Thursday morning was broken by the tread of many feet, the breaking of twigs and the alarmed movements of woodland folk, as the annual trek of intrepid fishermen got underway to open another fishing season.

Almost every enthusiastic fisherman was out trying to plow his way through to some favorite spot. Some arrived, others did not. The morning was chilly, and a light snowfall began about 6:30, but despite this the fishermen stuck it out in the hope of getting trout.

The majority was disappointed, however, as the trout were slow, and even the well baited hooks offered no temptation. A few did have some luck.

David Sorrey of Montague landed a lovely 4 lb. 3 oz salt water trout, 21 1-2 inches long and 11 inches in girth to take the prize offered by the Mabon Drug Company of Montague for the opening day's biggest trout.

Ken Clements landed a 3 lb 2 oz salt water trout, and Park Fraser, last year's winner, caught one over a pound and a half, so that although numbers may not have been caught, at least quality was the note of the day.

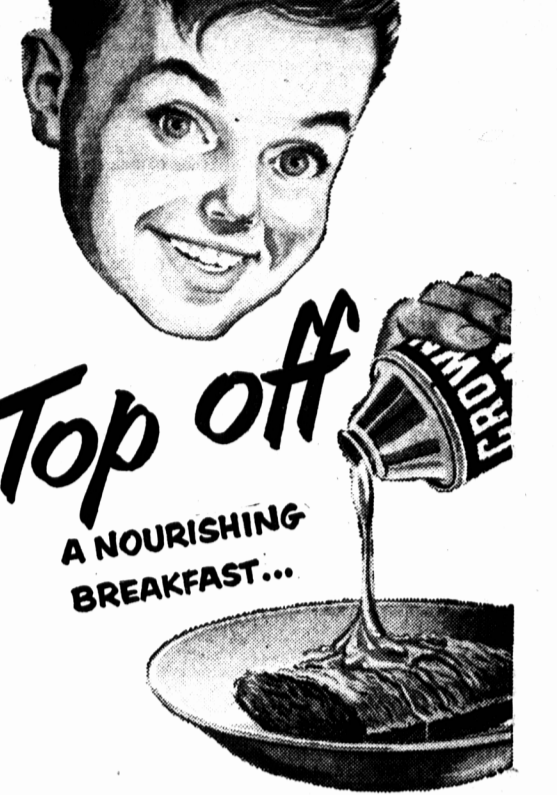
