BIGWIG INN, Ont., June 15 - (CP) - Dr. G. W. H. Scheepers of South Africa believes that silicosis, dread miners' disease, is virtually beaten, or will be when present information is sufficiently coordinated and put to use.

He stated this today in an address to the Ontario Mining Association and said the greatest recent advance is the aluminum therapy method developed at the McIntyre Research Foundation, sponsored by McIntyre Porcupine Mines, Ltd., a Northern Ontario gold company.
