Wollaston Corporal Commended For Work As Escort For War Dead

NEW YORK.—Cpl. William E. Stewart, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward S. Stewart of 86 Weston avenue, Wollaston, has been commended for outstanding performance of duty as a military escort in the program for returning American war dead, the Army announced today.

The commendation was in recognition of the manner in which the Wollaston man has performed the important mission of escorting the remains of American servicemen who lost their lives overseas in World War II, who have been brought back to this country for final burial.

Specially selected and trained military escorts like Corporal Stewart, acting as a personal representative of the Government accompany each deceased serviceman from the port of New York to the place of final burial. The escort presents the country's flag to the next of kin at the conclusion of the graveside service.

Corporal Stewart entered the service in 1943, served overseas with the 103th Infantry Division in France and Germany, and holds the ETO with two stars, also Victory and Occupation ribbons.

CLAIMS HE PROPOSED ROCKET-FIRING CRAFT

LONDON, April 18 — (CP) — The naval bombardment provided to support the 1942 Canadian raid on Dieppe was only one-sixth of what a military commander would have required in land warfare, Col. H. F. G. Langley told the Royal Commission on Awards to Invent-

ors. Langley presented his own case on a claim concerning combined-operations rocket and mortar craft. The commission recommends monetary awards to persons whose inventions aided Allied victory. The officer said the Dieppe raid proved conclusively that the old type of naval bombardment was totally inadequate in such opera-

tions. He had urged that a new fighting weapon was imperative if Allied forces were ever to invade Europe and avoid great casualties. Langley told the commission his proposal that the solution lay in rocket-firing craft met with widespread opposition. But after the invasion of North Africa rocket-equipped tank-landing craft were

used in every major amphibious operation.
