every month to compile the bureau's consumer price index for the following month, based on 1949 prices equalling 100. The index was 139.4 in August, just a tenth of a point off from its all-time peak. It later dropped another three-tenths of a point to 139.1 last month.

SHOES COST MORE
Two other major price increases in the past year have been in children's shoes and the cost of household help. From an index of 154.9 a year ago, children's shoe prices have moved to 169.1, and the household help index has risen to 202.3 from 184.4.

These are the largest increases among the individual items going into the all-items index. But they do not represent the most important components of the total index.

The cost of shelter and of household operations together make up 32 per cent of the total index, and food costs account for 27 per cent.

With the ups and downs of prices for various items of foodstuffs, the August food index meant that it cost \$13.78 for a sack of groceries which could be purchased a year ago for \$13.51. This is an increase of two per cent.

Soaps And Insurance Boosting Price Index

OTTAWA (CP) — Cleanliness now, and financial protection against automobile accident and sickness charges in the future, are the biggest contributors to recent increases in living costs. Compared with a year ago, the latest available official statistics shows:

1. It costs \$214.90 to obtain the automobile insurance which a year ago cost \$169.90.
2. It costs \$219.20 now to pay plan that a year ago cost \$193.20.
3. And toilet soap which cost for the prepaid medical care plan that a year ago cost \$193.20.
3. And toilet soap which cost

13 cents last year now costs more than 15 cents. These are increases of more than 25 per cent, 13 per cent and 15 per cent respectively.

The figures don't indicate the costs of specific insurance policies or brands of soap, but are among the results of the bureau of statistics' monthly survey of
