

Christmas Dinner Features Traditional Roast Goose



CAREER homemakers, take note. How would you like to prepare a plump roast goose, rich and juicy meat bursting under crackling crisp skin, basted with fresh unstrained orange juice and garnished with small clusters of grapes brushed with egg white, dusted with very fine ground blanched almond meats and dried in a draft of cool air to snowy whiteness?

EASY TO PREPARE Once the goose is in the oven, the entire meal can be forgotten for two hours, then finished in 45 minutes.

To do, make clever use of the new frozen boil-in-bag prepared vegetables which cook in 14 minutes. There are nine varieties from which to choose, already sauced to serve "as is," or for a talented hostess to use with imagination and flair as in the following menu.

Measurements are level
 Delmonico Potato Stuffing: Boil 4 pouches frozen prepared Delmonico potato for 14 min. Sauté 1 goose liver, chopped fine, in a little goose fat.

Combine potato and liver with ¼ tsp. black pepper, ½ tsp. poultry seasoning, 1 c. coarse-chopped cooked or canned peeled chestnuts (or use chopped pecans or walnuts), 2 c. fine soft bread crumbs, 2 tsp. minced parsley; ½ c. minced celery, 2 well-beaten eggs and ½ c. canned or cooked sliced small fresh mushrooms.

Enough for 14 lb. goose.
 Onion Baskets with Green Peas and Onions: Peel and boil 6 large onions in salted water for 20 min. Cool.

Remove centers, leaving shells ½-inch thick. Brush with melted butter. Broil 5 min to brown edges.

Fill with hot peas in onion sauce (frozen), prepared by pouch directions.
 Asparagus Muffins: Thaw 1 pkg. frozen asparagus cuts and tips Hollandaise by boiling pouch 5 min. Cool.

Into 2 c. biscuit mix toss 2 tbs. grated Parmesan.

Stir in 1 beaten egg, ½ c. milk and 2 tbs. melted butter. Fold in defrosted asparagus Hollandaise.

Bake 25 min. in hot oven, 400 degrees F., using muffin pans lined with paper baking cups.

Makes 12.
 Peach Melba a la Christmas (Individual Service): Use stemmed wide sherbet glasses.

Into each put chilled drained canned Elberta-peach half. Top with 1 scoop vanilla ice cream or ½ scoop each vanilla and pistachio ice cream. Spoon over chilled Melba sauce, purchased or homemade. Garnish with pistachio nut meats.
