MONTREAL, Dec. 2 - (CP) - Alexander Gray, Sr., Toronto industrialist, tonight predicted "a definite recession within 12 months if the war situation... does not grow worse."

When you talk to business executives they throw up their hands. Their plans are running to capacity. They have more business than they can handle, but they don't know where their steel and raw material is going to come from. They don't know what labor is going to ask. They don't know what the future may bring. So just to be safe they up prices a little.

"I have heard recently two sound policies. I understand Finance Minister Abbott has said privately that non-essential Government expenditures and non-essential staffs must be cut to the bone. Graham Towers of the Bank of Canada said he favored higher taxes to create a fair-sized budget credit balance in advance of increased defence expenditures."

"Too long have governments of all types been borrowing from Peter to pay Paul. A successful individual cannot do it."

"In my opinion, you have the answer to inflation - higher interest rates, credit control, non-essential spending of all governments cut to the bone to favor defence spending, heavier taxes to create budget credit balances to reduce debt. Increase production as much as possible from present plant and equipment; and, above all, you, the people, in this critical period buy only what you need and can pay for in cash, and save and invest in government bonds."
