Friendship is that clasping of hand with hand, and knitting of heart with heart in warm recognition of our absolute equality; (for are we not all children of one God, who is Father of us all?) and of the fact that despite his degradation and misery which may even result from his own grievous fault, man is a brother.

Love is the exercise of sympathy, affection and tenderness towards all men irrespective of creed or position, which never refuses to extend aid wherever needed in the alleviation of bodily and mental suffering, in the binding up of wounded hearts, in the pouring in of oil and wine of affectionate and tender solicitude, which protects and shields in the hour of danger and nurtures in the time of weakness, which strengthens in the time of weakness, and comforts in the hour of bereavement and distress.

Truth. "What is truth?" is a question that was first asked by Pilate of Him who stood before as Truth (God) Incarnate. And "what is truth?" must ever be found on the lips of earnest, thoughtful and noble men. God is the only thing that can be thought of or spoken of as Truth, and it is Him we are seeking when we grope, oftentimes blindly and stupidly, in the midst of the mental dimness of this sublunary sphere. But truth can only be found in the exercise of Friendship and Love towards our brothers and sisters, in whose persons we shall sooner or later see God. The cup of cold water given to a poor thirsty one is given to God. But our Order teaches us not alone to alleviate human suffering in its multitudinous forms we are taught not to be content with relieving distress and to educate and care for the widows and orphans, but we are also enjoined to bury the dead. And herein see again how the highest Christian teaching is emphasized by our Order. We tend and nurse a brother during his last illness, and we comfort him with kindly glances and loving words, bearing him, as it were, to the edge of the dark river of death, whose waters kiss our feet, where we reverently commit him to the keeping of Him who has promised to be with His own when they pass through the waters.

The future of Oddfellowship is absolutely dependent upon its individual members of the present. There was a time in its history when Oddfellows were anything but a credit to their Order, but that time has passed away, let us hope for ever, and now we find in its ranks some of the best and fairest of the sons of men. Let us, brethren, be true Oddfellows, live up with a loving strictness to the beautiful and lofty teachings of the lodge room, and, when we, in our turn, come to be tended and nursed, and then die, we may, having during our lives poured oil and wine into the bleeding wounds of our brethren, in this world, be received at the Jordan, from the hands of our surviving brethren, and carried by our God to His nearer presence.

Telephones in Sweden.

In probably no country in the world has the telephone come into more general use than in Sweden. Not only can Stockholm boast the most perfect telephonic arrangements of any capital, in addition to the largest percentage of telephonic subscribers, but the east coast and the west coast will soon be in telephonic communication, a line between Stockholm and Gothenburg being in course of erection. Many small towns are in telephonic communication with each other, and the number of subscribers is constantly increasing. In Malmo, for instance, which has about 40,000 inhabitants, there are six hundred subscribers; this town is connected with about thirty smaller towns and country places, with subscribers ranging between two hundred and ten. In Norway also there are several new lines in course of construction.
