

S. Planning Near End on Quoddy Power Project

WASHINGTON (CP)—United States planning is nearly finished on the long-proposed Passamaquoddy tidal power project and allied Saint John River plants, Interior Secretary Stewart Udall said here.

A move for congressional action will be made next year as well as negotiations with Canada for its necessary approval.

"I think the Canadian officials certainly should be encouraged by this report," Udall told a Senate subcommittee in a specific reference under questioning to some New Brunswick concern about the impact on fisheries in the Bay of Fundy.

Udall and Army Secretary Stephen Abner testified for two hours before the Senate subcommittee on rivers and harbors flood control, presenting another chapter in economic and engineering studies ordered three years ago by the late President Kennedy.

Saint John River will affect only a small portion of New Brunswick territory. But the seven miles of dike, generators, fishways and other tidal-power works on the Passamaquoddy will lie mainly in Canadian territory.

Only a handful of senators attended Wednesday's hearing and none indicated any opposition. Among them was Pierre Salinger, newly appointed Democrat for California, who recalled flying over Passamaquoddy in 1962 with the late president as his press aide. He said Kennedy had an "infectious" interest in the scheme for a number of years.

Senator Edmund Muskie (Dent. Me.), the chairman, said the project "makes sense as a resource utilization," adding: "It is essential to revitalization of a sagging local economy."

The U.S. proposes to handle the bulk of the cost and Canada will get about one-fifth of the estimated annual power output of 3,300,000 kilowatt hours annually.

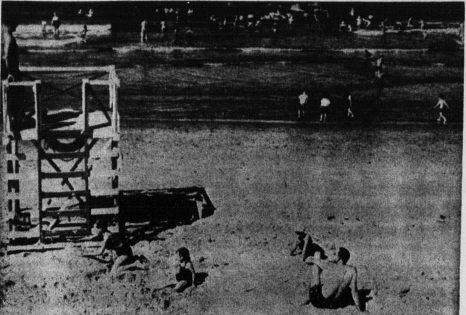
