NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market declined Wednesday as the second trading session as volume shrank to the lowest level in more than ten weeks. Stocks were fairly steady in early trading as they recovered from a major decline in the previous week. But there was no great incentive to buy, and the market's response as to whether a crippling auto strike would be called next Monday.

On the last session Canadian Pacific was down 1/2 after a concern. To it was added later in the day news that the Canadian rail strike is possible by Sept. 6.

The Dow Jones industrial average lost 2.98 at 829.21. International steel, which plunged 12 points to 73 after trading it divided by 75 cents from 81.

The Associated Press average of 40 stocks fell 1.0 to 312.6. Airlines were unsettled when a major brokerage house downgraded its recommendations on most of them.
