BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM WAGE FOR LABOURERS ON CONTRACT WORK

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:

No person shall engage or hire any labourer or working for any Federal election and the annual meeting of Kings County Liberal Association will be held at Georgetown Hall, Thursday, August 9th, at 8 p.m. Advanced Time. All poll chairmen are requested to call a poll meeting immediately and appoint five delegates.

Any person or persons, including officers of any corporation, found guilty of an infraction of this by-law upon trial by way of summary conviction before the Stipendiary Magistrate of the City, shall be liable to pay to the common jail of the said City for any period not exceeding Forty days, unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.
