

U Thant Works To Prevent Russian Fees Showdown

UNITED NATIONS (AP)—
European sources warn the Soviet Union and its 10 Communist allies will walk out of the United Nations if they lose their votes in the general assembly for failing too far behind in their dues.
Secretary-General U Thant regards the threat as serious and is working urgently behind the scenes to prevent a showdown before the assembly begins its 19th annual session Nov. 10.
The crux of the matter is refusal of the Russians and their allies to pay special assessments for UN peace-keeping operations in the Congo and the Middle East. They regard both projects with distaste.
Article 17 of the UN charter says any member who fails two calendar years behind in his overall dues "shall have no vote in the general assembly."
Fifteen countries are that far behind because they have been unwilling or unable to pay their share of the costs of the peace-keeping operations.
Seven are Communists—the Soviet Union, the Ukraine, Byelorussia, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland and Romania. Eight are non-Communists—Argentina, Bolivia, Nationalist China, Guatemala, Haiti, Paraguay, Uruguay and Yemen.
REFUSE TO PAY
In addition, four other Communist countries—Albania, Bulgaria and Mongolia—refuse to pay the peace-keeping assessments, but not so far behind in overall dues, because their regular assessments are low.
Arrears for the Congo force total nearly \$83,000,000 and for the Middle East force nearly \$100,000,000. The United States has covered much of the deficit and the U.S. Congress wants the loans repaid.
Although the U.S. has no plan to drive the Russians out of the UN, it is organizing, thereby ending its function as a meeting place between East and West. American diplomats note the charter is quite clear about voting rights for delinquent members.
The Soviet Union contends no member can be deprived of its vote without two-thirds consent. It also contends the peace-keeping operations are illegal. That came away from talks with Premier Khrushchev in Moscow last month convinced the Russians are serious about their threat to quit the assembly—and even the UN—if they lose their vote.

RUSSIA BLUFFING?
In Washington, U.S. officials subsequently told Thant the Russians are bluffing and that they would eventually pay their bills in the face of solid opposition. They note, for example, Khrushchev has dropped his demand for a troika UN secretariat in which the West, Communist and neutralist blocs each would have a veto.
Thant, nevertheless, is worried that a vote against the Russians in the assembly would drive them out of the organization.
Some diplomats are hopeful.

MISSILES IN CUBA
RIO DE JANEIRO (Reuters)—The sister of Cuban Premier Fidel Castro said Sunday there are still offensive Soviet missiles in Cuba Juanita Castro, 21, who defected from Cuba last June and denounced her brother's regime, arrived in Brazil for a visit as the guest of Foreign Minister Vasco Lottao de Omba.

Suspended Member In Que. Says He'll Be Back In Fall

TROIS-RIVIERES, Que. (CP)—Yves Gabias, Union Nationale member recently suspended for three years from the Quebec legislative assembly, says he will be back in his seat representing the Trois-Rivieres riding at the start of the fall session.
Mr. Gabias also said in an interview here that he will contest the party leadership of Daniel Johnson at the next Union Nationale convention because he feels the latter is not sufficiently aggressive and seems to fear the Liberal government.
The opposition member said he will show the assembly committee on elections and privileges it made a mistake July 29 in suspending him for accusing Attorney-General Rene Hamel of bribe-taking, then failing to substantiate his charge.
Following his suspension, Mr. Gabias said he would resign if his electors so desired.
"I haven't met one of my voters since who asked me to quit my seat and instead was given their full support in my fight to denounce the sacred cows of the Liberal party," he said.
"I will fight until I have won final and total victory," he said. "I am searching for the truth in this bribe issue and I will find it."
Mr. Gabias criticized Mr. Johnson for his party leadership in the assembly and his handling of internal party procedures.

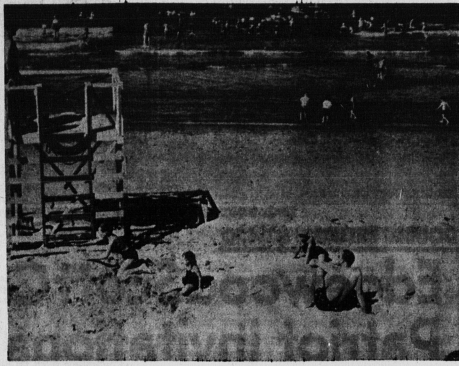
