MONTREAL (CP) — All sections with the exception of primary metals traded ground Friday in active trading on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges. The industrial volume closed at 255,000 shares while mines and oils traded 1,562,900 shares. The composite index moved up one point to 167.5 as advances outnumbered declines 114 to 67.

Banks led the advance up 1 1/2 to 135.8. Royal jumped 1 1/2 to 82 1/2. Imperial 1/2 to 70 and Montreal 1/2 to 68. Nova Scotia slipped 1/4 to 80 1/2.

Industrials rose one point to 167.5. Imperial Tobacco jumped 1/2 to 15% followed by Dominion Textile and Du Pont up 1/4 to 30 and 56 1/4.

Papers were up 0.7 to 142.2. Consolidated rose 1/4 to 41 1/4. Abitibi 1/4 to 18 1/4. B. C. Forest dropped 3/4 to 29 1/4.

Utilities were up 0.5 to 158.6. In other sections base metals, machinery, senior oils, food and beverage and trade and finance were higher.

TORONTO (CP)—Industrials lacked on healthy gains in moderate stock exchange trading Friday. Denison Mines and two affiliates stole the spotlight.

Rumors concerning a large uranium contract and a possible merger have swirled around Denison for weeks.

Denison gained 2 1/2 to 27 1/2 after hitting a high of 27 1/2. It traded 47,830 shares. Affiliate Roman Corp. rose 35 cents to \$7.75 and traded at a high of \$7.80.

In the main list, Imperial Oil, Distillers Seagram and Canada Packers B added 1/2 to 50, 34 1/2 and 8 1/4. B.C. Forest Products and Canadian Industrial Gas gained 1/2 to 29 1/2 and 12 1/2. CIG hit a high of 13.

John Labatt and Trans-Canada Pipe each rose to 22 and 4 1/4 and Abitibi 1/2 to 15 1/2.

Rockwell rose two to 75 cents among speculative, and traded 131,150 shares.

Gold and oils were quiet. On index, industrials rose .95 to a high of 172.54 and base metals 1.03 to their high of 171.21.

The exchange index was up .95 to 161.68, golds 1.33 to 171.21 and Western oils .39 to 90.61. Volume was 3,983,000 shares compared with 3,413,000.
