

## N.S. Geochemical Mapping Seen Aid In Base Metals Hunt

OTTAWA (CP) — Maps of a unique kind, called geochemical maps and depicting chemical make-up of soil as well as geographical features, have been made of the northern half of the Nova Scotia mainland and are to be released Dec. 8 by the Geological Survey of Canada.

The department of mines and technical surveys in an announcement Wednesday said the maps are expected to be of great value in the search for promising base-metal areas. It said prior announcement of their release to the public is made so all prospectors and exploration companies may receive the information on the same date.

The information contained in the maps was gained by making on-the-spot, ultra-sensitive, chemical analyses of some 3,000 samples of silt and sand. These were collected from nearly every stream in northern Nova Scotia and later analyzed in Ottawa laboratories for lead, zinc and copper content.

The results were then plotted

to make the four geochemical maps — one each dealing with copper, lead, zinc and heavy metals. Each map consists of two sheets, and is on a scale of one inch to four miles.

They are the first of their kind to be produced in Canada and are believed the first ever published of such a large area.

The announcement said the geological survey expects to continue production of such maps — providing a more direct picture of economically valuable areas than existing geological maps — with New Brunswick and northern Ontario probably the next areas to be covered.

A special feature are isograds — lines similar to contours on topographical maps — which indicate the richness of trace-metal contents of the sediments examined. Dots show where stream samples were taken.

"Many of the anomalously high areas thus revealed can be related to underlying geological features and may indicate the presence of mineralized bedrock," the announcement said.

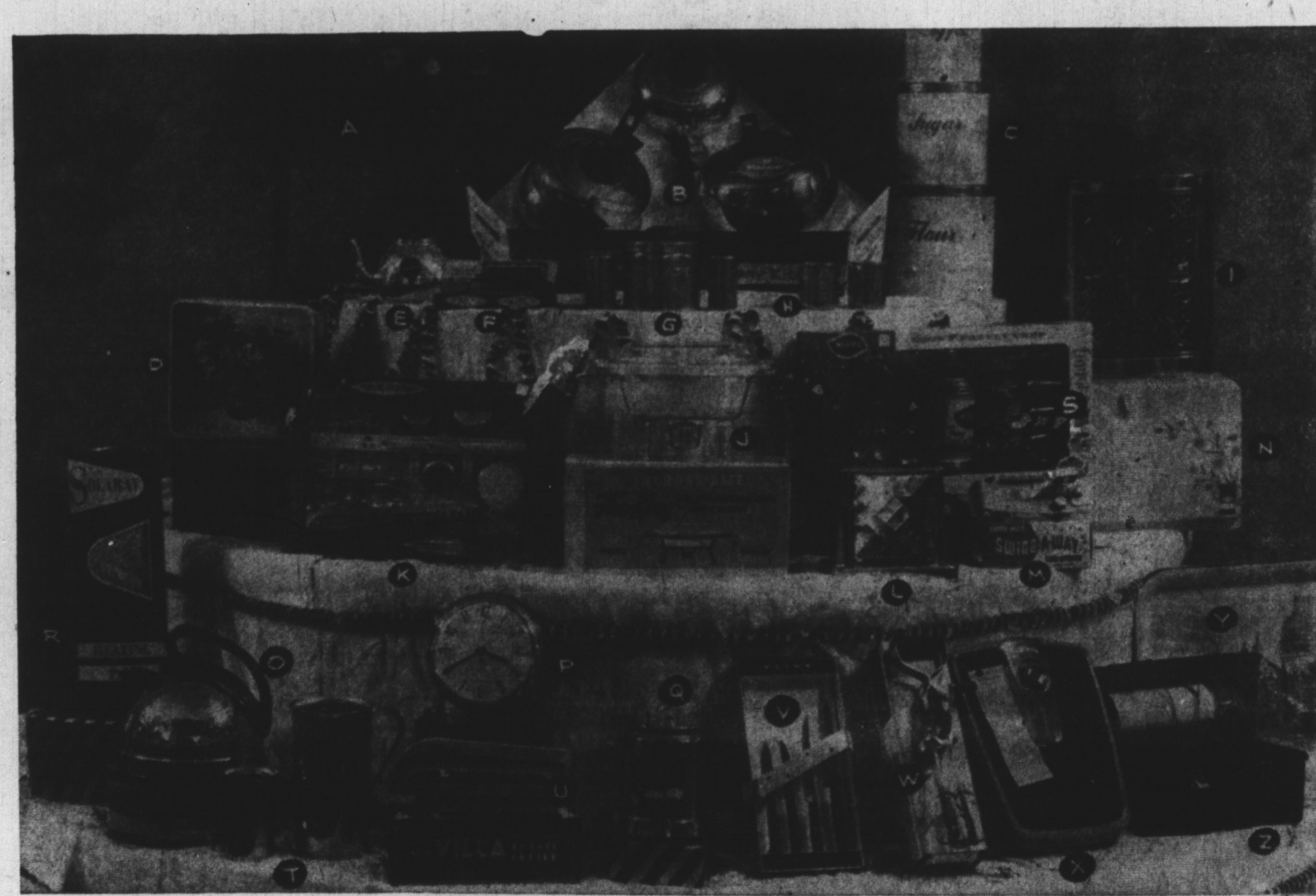
