## Construction Of Ship Yard Office Building Is Underway

GEORGETOWN — Recent rains have impeded to a certain extent but not appreciably delayed the placing of form and foundation footings for the new office building on the site of Bostwick Marine Limited's Georgetown shipyard.

Workers, under carpenter foreman, Albert Shiner, of Georgetown last week completed the building of forms for the foundation of the 16-foot by 20-foot office building. By the weekend M. F. Schurman Co. Ltd., had completed running approximately 100 yards of ready-mixed cement and this week will see the forms dismantled and the construction started on the placing of the floor joist and wall studs.

The concrete foundation is reinforced by three-quarter inch steel rods, placed one foot apart.

The foundation around the building has six-foot high walls which are eight inches wide.

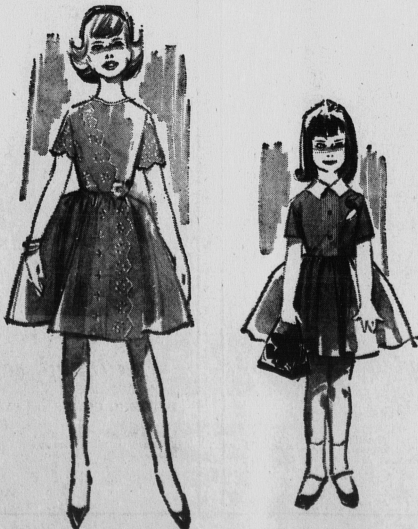
