Imperial Oil To Build Plant DARTMOUTH, N.S. (CP) - Imperial Oil Ltd. announced Wednesday that a contract to build an \$850,000 Heptene plant at the company's Dartmouth refinery has been awarded to Canadian Badger Co. Ltd. of Toronto.

The announcement said work will begin in the late fall and is expected to be completed in the first quarter of 1967.

Imperial Oil's first venture into the petrochemical field in the Maritimes was a sulphur extraction plant at the refinery, begun last November and expected to be completed in the near future.

The main part of the new installation will consist of two 100-foot steel towers, some 50 men will be involved in the construction.

Heptene is a petrochemical derived from crude oil and is used in the manufacture of isocetyl alcohol, which in turn is used to manufacture esters which are employed by the plastics industry to improve the processing and physical properties of plastics.

The Shillington Trophy awarded to the runner-up in the competition, went to No. 15 Medical Company of London, Ont., commanded by Lt.-Col. M.T. Dillon.

The Ryerson Trophy is named after Col. G. Sterling Ryerson, who in 1907 was president of the Association of Officers of the Medical Service of Canada.
