Hostility To Pflimlin As Premier Mounts

PARIS (AP) — Premier-designate Pierre Pflimlin, refusing to yield to political opposition and threats of street rioting in Algiers, insisted Monday night that he will stick to his original plan and face Parliament for approval today. He called in Robert Lacoste, caretaker minister in Algiers, and discussed the handling of a general strike and mass demonstrations that have been called for the hour when Pflimlin faces the National Assembly. The Algiers "committee of vigilance," grouping war veterans and dighard elements among French settlers in Algeria, have called for their supporters to protest what they fear is a surrender policy.

TEETERING SITUATION
In Paris, the political situation teetered back and forth as parties held meetings. The Socialists decided 63 to 8 to give Pflimlin their votes for investiture but not to join his cabinet. The Radical Socialists, with only four adverse votes, decided full support. The Independents (moderate conservatives) voted 46 to 27 against joining the government but, because there was no two-thirds majority, individual party members can serve as members for Pflimlin if they wish.

Despite all the furor, Pflimlin's Algeria policy as thus far announced — cease-fire negotiations when possible and then free elections, but military reinforcement until the right moment for a political solution arrives — differs little from that of his predecessors, especially Guy Mollet. Pflimlin's 17-man cabinet, announced Monday, showed mostly old faces. Most prominent were Edgar Faure as finance minister, Rene Pleven as foreign minister and Andre Mitter as minister for Algeria.

BENEVENTO, Italy (Reuters) — Thieves broke into the basilica of Our Lady of Grace Sunday night and stole consecrated offerings of gold, silver and gems worth about 50,000,000 lire (about \$30,000). The booty included two Papal gifts — a golden pen from Pope Benedict XIII (1724-1730) and a golden ring from Pope Pius IX (1846-1878).
