Through their many contacts these two organizations are constantly working for the improvement of the status of the teaching profession as a means to the achievement of better education for Canada.

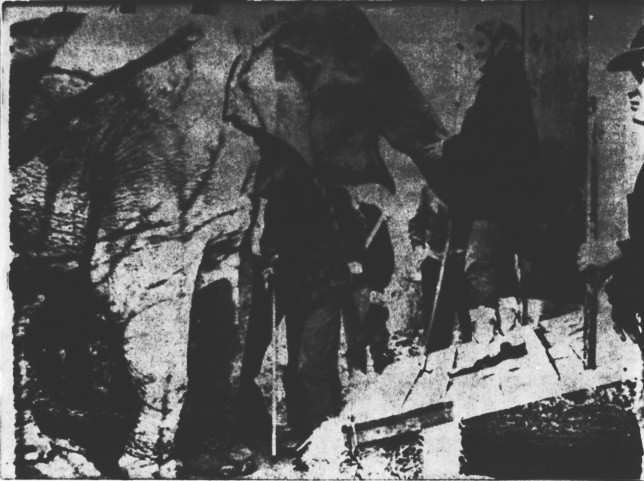
