LAC MEGANTIC, Que. (CP)—Consulting engineer Marc Benoit said here the danger of the Gaysburg Dam flooding the Chaudiere Valley has ended.

"All danger is positively past," the engineer, hired by Lac Megantic when the menace of the manically-erected dam became apparent, said. "The dam will hold."

Benoit said the present level of the 4,000-cubic foot reservoir at the dam is 1.37 feet above the level considered dangerous.

The situation was mentioned in the legislature Tuesday when Eloi Guillemette (UN - Frontenac) asked if Dr. Leo Casagrande, a prominent American engineer, studied the dam personally and submitted a written report on the dam.

Natural Resources Minister Rene Levesque replied that a report dated Feb. 9 hearing Mr. Casagrande's signature was given him by the town of Lac Megantic. It was drawn up and approved by Shawmut Water and Power Company, not the province.

Dr. Casagrande is professor of Foundations Engineering at Harvard University.

The natural resources department quoted the Casagrande report as concluding that the fill of the dam and granular dam was in a poor state.

Dr. Casagrande, in a telephone interview from his home in Cambridge, England, confirmed that he had clearly labelled the dam unsafe even though he said some parts of his report were misinterpreted in Mr. Levesque's report to the legislature.

"From the very first time I saw that dam in 1964, I didn't like it," he said.

"I don't think Mr. Levesque exaggerated the danger."

CONTRACT BRIDGE

TEST YOUR PLAY

You are declarer with the West hand at Six Hearts. North leads the four of diamonds. How would you play the hand?

WAKJ1084 N AQ9752
A2 S Q883
4A94

This is strictly a percentage proposition. There is no way of guaranteeing the slam, but there is a way to give yourself the maximum chance of making the contract.

Three or three different methods of playing the hand that stand out. They all start the same way: declarer takes the diamond with the ace, draws both averse trumps, cashes the king of diamonds, and ruffs a diamond. Then:

Method No. 1. Declarer takes a spade finesse. Assume it loses to the king and a spade is returned to the ace. Declarer plays a club to the ace and a club back. If North follows low, the jack is finessed.

This method wins if North was dealt either the king of spades or queen of clubs. It gives the declarer two chances to win.

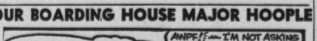

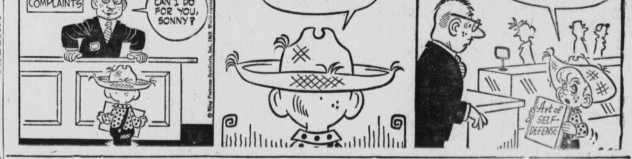

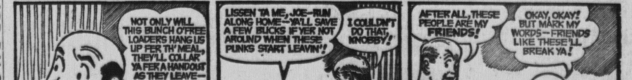
